Time

Half Marathon & 10k start at 9:00 AM. Registration and packet pickup begins at 7:30 AM. Race-day registration will close at 8:45 AM.

Location

The Evergreen State College Campus. Registration and packet pickup will be in the Indoor Soccer Pavilion at the playfields. Parking is available in F Lot (Overhulse and Driftwood) and the main parking lot (C-lot) off of the Evergreen Parkway main entrance. Visit www.evergreen.edu/tour for more information.

Course

The course starts and finishes near the pavilion and takes runners onto the rural roads and bike paths surrounding the campus and follows wide shoulders the majority of the race. The course will be well marked (including mile markers), monitored at intersections and will have water stations. To reduce encounters with the minimal car traffic, there will be an out and back section in the last 4 miles of the course.

Background

The original Geoduck Gallop was established in 1984, but only lasted through the following year. Formerly a pledge run/walk, in 2006 it was re-invented as a Half Marathon and a 10k road run/walk. The race was set up as a qualifying course for Evergreen Track and Field Team members wishing to run the standard for the NAIA National Championships Marathon and opened to the public. In three years the run has brought in over \$1000 of food donations for the Thurston County Food Bank.

The Food Bank relies largely on community support. In-Kind donations of food and volunteers are at the core of the annual budget. Community food drives keep the shelves stocked and volunteers keep the doors open. Administrative costs are kept to a minimum, accounting for less than 5 percent of the annual budget. The Thurston County Food Bank serves over 22,000 households annually. 49,000 people accessed the food banks in 2005, roughly one eighth of Thurston Counties population. Half of those helped were children.

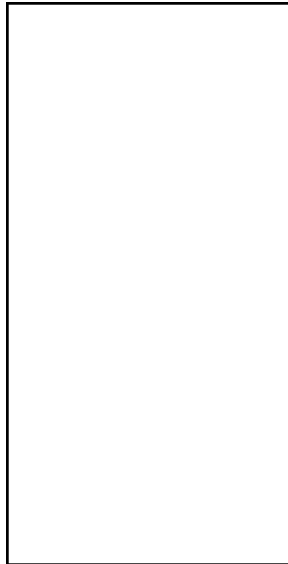
