## The 90th Minute

This week marks the final week of the 2011 season for the Geoducks, who have battled hard in every game they've played. The squad will look to wrap up the campaign on a positive note this week as they travel to Everett on Wednesday for a non-conference tilt with Trinity Lutheran before returning to Olympia on Saturday to battle Northwest Christian in a Cascade Conference counter.

## By The Numbers

The Geoducks continue to lead the conference in saves, both in total numbers (107) and saves per game (6.69). Individually, **Christian Pettit** is fifth in the CCC in saves (63) and is second in saves per game (5.73). Freshman teammate **Mitch Treend** is third in saves per game at 5.12.

## Scouting Trinity Lutheran

The Eagles head into Wednesday's game with a record of 11-4-1 on the season, coming off a 3-1 win at NCAA Division II Western Washington on Monday. TLC defeated Evergreen, 2-0, back on Aug. 19 in the season-opener for both school. Individual statistic for Trinity Lutheran were not available as of Nov. 1.

## Scouting Northwest Christian

The Beacons currently sit at 3-13-1 on the season, including 1-11-1 in CCC play, having picked up their first conference win of the season on Saturday against College of Idaho. On offense, Chris Longi and Alex Crossingham each have three goals, combining for 60% of the NCU scoring. Nick Kratzke has seen the majority of time in net, allowing 29 goals in 1124:59 for a 2.32 GAA and a .663 save percentage.
