Discussed need/interest in a total of four or five student members. Wendy proposed waiting for GSU appointment process to play out, which might occur by fifth week. Wendy made basic/ “no brainer” edits based on this feedback; sought input from Colleen on others; and will bring the balance to the Committee for discussion.

- Andi met with Colleen Warren, legal counsel for Evergreen, to discuss proposed Code. Colleen identified components for which she will have some guidance:
  - use of brief adjudicative process for all hearings except expulsion
  - role of attorney in the hearing
  - how/where to include “motivated by bias”
  - jurisdiction extension to adjacent/off-campus
  - obstruction/disruption standard
  - threshold for sexual misconduct standard
  - “replica” in the firearm standard

Colleen will join the Committee on October 14 to share her analysis
