I understand that to receive financial assistance at The Evergreen State College:

1. I must be a United States citizen or an eligible non-citizen.
2. I must be fully admitted to Evergreen State College as a matriculated (degree-seeking) student (not a "special" student or a "provisionally admitted" student) and eligible to enroll.
3. Regardless of what I indicated on the FAFSA, my initial awards are based on fulltime enrollment and if I enroll less than full time, a reduction or cancellation of my financial aid (including loan proceeds) may result (www.evergreen.edu/financialaid/essential_info.htm).
4. I must notify the Financial Aid Office immediately if I change my enrollment plans, withdraw from Evergreen, take a leave of absence, reduce my credit hours, stop attending, or if I change residency status.
5. My enrollment status will be 'locked' (permanently recorded) and used to determine my financial aid eligibility **on the 10th day of the quarter**. If I reduce my enrollment below that for which aid was disbursed prior to the lock date, I may owe a repayment of funds I received when enrolled for more credits.
6. I must make satisfactory academic progress to continue to receive financial aid (www.evergreen.edu/financialaid/SAP_Policy.htm).
7. If I withdraw, take a leave of absence, or fail to attend class between the first day of a quarter and the 60% point of that quarter, I may be required to repay some or all of the financial aid I received for that quarter and future financial aid may be placed on hold (www.evergreen.edu/financialaid/policies.htm).
8. I must be working toward a first Bachelor's or Master's degree in order to be considered for most types of financial aid other than Federal Direct Loans.
9. I must immediately report any changes in resources to the Financial Aid Office. Examples include, but are not limited to changes and/or additions in educational benefits, tribal grants, DVR, scholarships, etc. Increased resources may result in decreases to my other financial aid awards including possible repayment for financial aid I have already received, including loan proceeds.
10. I am responsible for repaying any funds (including loan proceeds) I receive that cannot reasonably be attributed to meeting my educational expenses at Evergreen State College for the period of this award. The amount of such repayment may include collection costs incurred by the college.
11. If I am a first-time Federal Direct Loan recipient **at Evergreen**, I am required to complete "loan entrance counseling" and to sign a new Master Promissory Note before taking receipt of my first loan disbursement. All Direct Loan borrowers must complete an exit counseling session when leaving Evergreen .
12. I authorize the payment of any charges incurred each quarter at Evergreen with my financial aid from that quarter, before I receive any excess financial aid. Charges from a prior quarter will not automatically be paid with aid from a current or future quarter.

This form must be signed and returned to the Financial Aid Office to indicate you understand and agree to all the conditions for receiving a financial aid award at Evergreen.
