Summer 2009 Financial Aid Application Policy and Procedure

Complete and return the Summer Interest Form by **May 08, 2009**. If your interest form is late, be prepared to pay tuition with personal funds or an ACT Short Term Loan. Your budget and offers will be based on the number of credits you have indicated that you intend to enroll in and whether they are at the graduate and/or undergraduate level.

Registration for Classes

You must complete your Summer registration (both 1st and 2nd sessions) by June 26, 2009 to receive financial aid funding during the Summer Quarter. You will be allowed **one** change to registration. Exceptions will be considered if classes are cancelled.

Important Loan Information

If you will change grade levels from freshman to sophomore (45 credits) or sophomore to junior (90 credits) before Summer, you must submit Credit Verification Forms confirming the grade level change before Stafford Loans will be certified at the more advanced grade level. These forms are available at the Financial Aid Office or on the Financial Aid website. Attempted or incomplete credit does not prove a grade level change. The last day to certify Summer Loans for the first session is July 17th, and for full or second session the last day to certify loans is August 28th. Apply for loans as soon as you can after receiving a Summer Financial Aid offer.

Available Financial Aid Programs for Summer Quarter

Since Summer Quarter is part of the 2008-2009 Academic Year, only unused 2008-2009 eligibility for Stafford Subsidized or Unsubsidized Loans can be awarded. See *How to Get a Loan* on the Financial Aid website for maximum annual loan eligibility. Students who have not exhausted their maximum Pell Grant during the academic year may be able to receive it during the Summer Quarter. Most other financial aid programs (such as State Need Grant and tuition waivers, etc.) are unavailable during Summer. When we receive your Summer Interest Form, we will determine whether you have remaining Pell Grant or Stafford Loan eligibility. Parent PLUS Loans and Graduate PLUS Loans will also be offered to cover Summer costs.

Summer Work-Study

The deadline to apply for Summer Work-Study is April 24. If you are interested in applying for Summer Work-Study, information and applications are available at the Student Employment website, or call 360-867-5520. If you are working under the full-time Summer Work-Study Program, you will not be eligible to receive other Summer Quarter Financial Aid.

Timing of Awards

The Financial Aid Office will begin making awards on May 11, to students who have submitted Summer Interest Forms by the deadline, May 8. Remember, Summer Financial Aid will be based on the number of credits you indicated on the Summer Interest Form.

Withdrawing from Summer Classes

If you decide not to attend, **you will not be automatically dropped**. You must officially drop your enrollment **even** if you do not accept the financial aid offered. If you fail to formally withdraw, you will have to pay for credits you enrolled in.

- Students may not receive both Summer Quarter financial aid and Summer Quarter Work-Study.
