

Displaced Student Tuition Waiver Program

Waivers are contingent on the availability of funds.

Offered to international and domestic students attending The Evergreen State College whose educations have been interrupted by military conflict or natural disaster. Financial need may be considered. Waivers are renewable up to four academic years providing that recipients maintain satisfactory academic progress for the duration they are receiving the waiver.

Requirements

International Applicants:

- Meet the published admissions criteria including TOEFL scores and admissions application deadline.
- Demonstrate that you have sufficient sources of funding for all non-tuition related expenses, such as travel, housing, meals, books, insurance, and other living costs.

Domestic Applicants:

- Meet the published admissions criteria and admissions application deadline.
- Submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to the federal processor.

Application Process

- Submit to the Enrollment Services Office no later than September 5, 2008 a letter of application explaining your achievements and why you wish to attend Evergreen. Include in your letter a statement addressing your circumstances as they pertain to this waiver.
- Waivers are renewable up to four academic years providing that recipients maintain satisfactory academic progress for the duration they are receiving the waiver.
