Notes: **Any Pell:** student received Pell grant at any point while at Evergreen. This matches the HECB/OFM Accountability framework definition requirements, but it also means that cohort sizes will change for this group and the No Pell group each year that data is updated. Some students who do not receive Pell grant support in their first year will receive Pell grant later in their time at Evergreen; such a student would move out of the NoPell cohort into the AnyPell cohort. **FirstGen:** Neither the student's mother or father completed a four-year college degree, as indicated by the student at time of application to Evergreen. **Disability:** Student reported a documented disability to Evergreen. **No Disability:** Student not known by the college to have a documented disability. **KEY served:** Student received services through Evergreen's federally-funded TRIO student support services program, KEY Services. **Elig./No KEY:** Student is first-generation, has disability, or is low income (currently determined by Pell status), but did NOT receive KEY Services. **Not Elig for KEY:** Student not known to be first generation, have disability, and has not received Pell grant; thus, would not be eligible for KEY services.
