

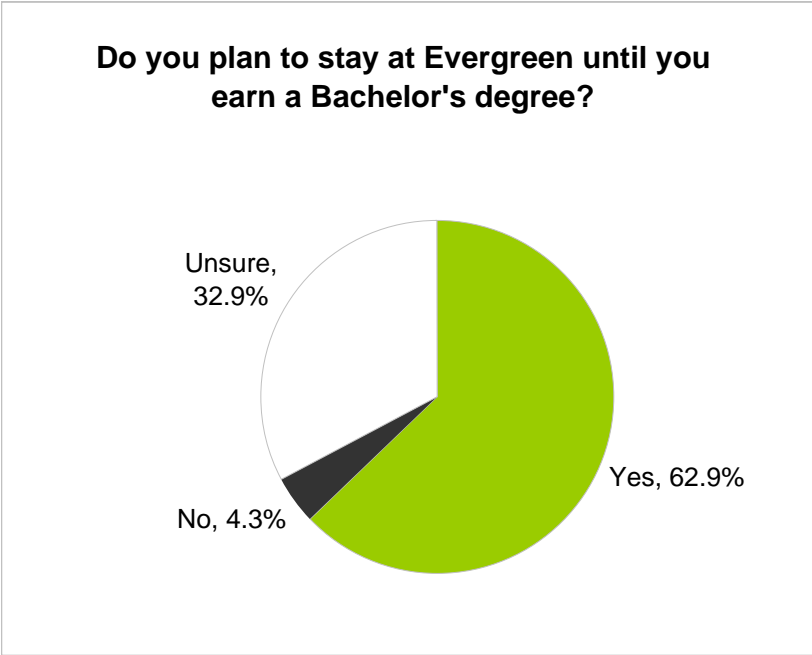

Evergreen Student Experience Survey 2008
Responses of First-Time, First-Year Students

Plans to Stay at Evergreen

Students were asked to indicate whether they planned to stay at Evergreen until earning a Bachelor's Degree. About 63% of first-time, first-year respondents indicated that they planned to stay at Evergreen. Almost 33% of respondents reported that they were unsure whether they would stay at Evergreen and 4.3% said they did not plan to stay at Evergreen.

Respondents who were not planning to stay at Evergreen or who were unsure about staying were asked to mark the items in a list that pertained to their situation. Five of the respondents who indicated that they would not stay at Evergreen indicated that they planned to attend another institution. Two were not satisfied with academics at Evergreen and one said (s)he was not able to continue for financial reasons. Two indicated "Other", and wrote comments explaining their situation (these comments are listed below).

Among respondents who were unsure whether they would stay, almost 59% indicated that they planned to attend another institution, 13.0% stated they were not attending Evergreen to earn a degree, 21.7% were not satisfied with academics, 13.0% would not be able to continue for financial reasons, and 32.4% indicated "Other," many of whom included a comment explaining why they were unsure about whether they would stay (these comments are listed below).

The following are "Other" comments from those students who said that they did not intend to stay at Evergreen:
