 Primary Area of Study or Concentration

Students were asked to describe their primary field(s) of study or concentration at Evergreen. The open-ended responses to this question were coded into the Classification for Instructional Programs (CIP) 2000 codes. Some respondents wrote in more than one field of study, so percentages do not add up to 100%. The greatest proportion of Tacoma campus respondents indicated an interest in Public Administration and Social Service Professions (45.0%); Psychology(20.0%); Legal Professions and Studies (18.3%); and English Language and Literature/Letters (15.0%).

The following table shows responses in mutually exclusive categories therefore each respondent is represented only once within the categories. Responses that include one or two planning unit are listed below. Only totals are reported for respondents that indicated three or more planning units; these data are available upon request.

The highest percentage of respondents reported only one planning unit or division representing their academic choices at Evergreen (54.1% of respondents). Almost 20% of respondents (19.7%) reported two planning units. The highest percentage of respondents (41.0%) reported Tacoma Program only as best representing their academic choices at Evergreen. Another 6.6% reported Tacoma Program and Society, Politics, Behavior and Change.

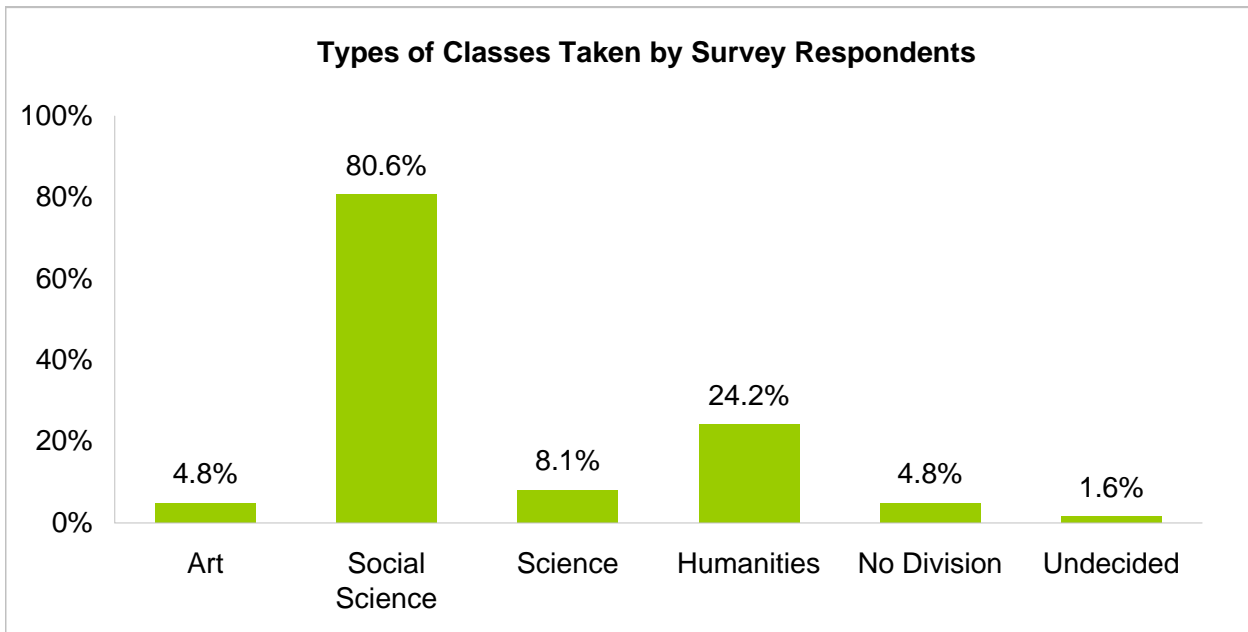

Students were asked to describe their primary field(s) of study or concentration at Evergreen. The open-ended responses to this question were grouped into the four academic divisions: art, social science, science, and humanities. Responses could include more than one field of study or fields of study that are encompassed by more than one division so percentages do not add up to 100%. The greatest proportion of Tacoma respondents indicated a Social Science as a primary field of study (80.6%), followed by Humanities (24.2%), Science (8.1%), and Art (4.8%). 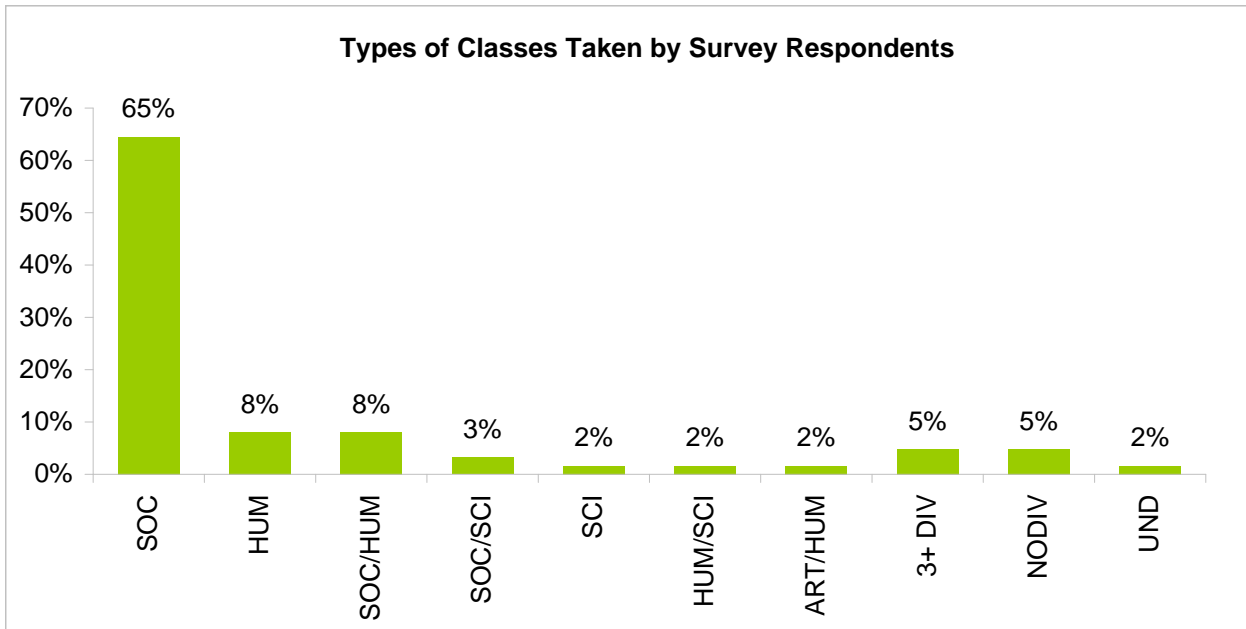


### Primary Area of Study or Concentration - Divisional Analysis, Mutually Exclusive Categories

The open-ended responses to this question were grouped into the four academic divisions: art, social science, science, and humanities. The greatest proportion of Tacoma campus respondents indicated Social Science only as their primary field of study (64.5%), followed by Humanities only (8.1%), Social Science and Humanities (8.1%), Three or More Divisions (4.8%), and No Division (4.8%).
