

When you give to the Evergreen Scholarship Fund, you foster the joy of learning and propel students towards their degrees. The Evergreen Scholarship Fund provides renewable awards that increase typically from \$2,000 for first-year students to \$3,000 for seniors.



#### HOW SCHOLARSHIPS CHANGE LIVES

Evergreen's fiercely ambitious students come ready to learn and create positive change in the world. They come here at pivotal moments of growth. Whether right out of high school or right out of the military, they are ready to chart their own pathways for the future. Their goals and dreams fuel their passion for learning.

However, financial hardships can be a roadblock along this journey. Many students find themselves in the difficult position of choosing between their education or meeting the basic needs of themselves or their families. About 34% of Evergreen's current student body identify as low-income and 20% are the first in their families to go to college. The support you provide through the Evergreen Foundation Scholarship and the Art of Giving eliminate this choice for many students.

Evergreen Foundation Scholarships provide financial security allowing students to focus on their learning. These scholarships create access for those who would otherwise face financial barriers and hardships and gives them the opportunity to learn, climb, and contribute to our shared democracy.

With the help of Evergreen Foundation Scholarships, students leave ready for law school, tribal leadership, social entrepreneurship, public service, science, and the arts. #### EMILY KOHRING, MPA CLASS OF 2023 EVERGREEN GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP& STUDENT EMERGENCY FUND RECIPIENT

Emily wanted to earn her Master of Public Administration (MPA) at Evergreen so she could expand her breadth of knowledge and serve as an advocate in her community.

Emily earned her bachelor's in public health from the University of Washington. When applying for master's programs, she considered a few institutions before deciding to attend

Evergreen Tacoma. At Evergreen Tacoma, Emily had the chance to use her own life experiences in her courses. "It was truly a hands-on experience that molds students. Because the content of the classes comes from what each student contributes," says Emily.

Being a mom and going to school while working full-time gave Emily a fear of accumulating debt during her master's studies. Her advisors were quick to share information on financial resources, resulting in Emily receiving the Evergreen Graduate Scholarship, which is also bolstered by donors to The Evergreen Fund. With support from Evergreen Financial Aid and the generosity of donors like you, Emily was surprised and grateful to find her first year in the MPA program covered without taking on the added stress of student loan debt.

#### **OVERCOMING CHALLENGES**

Then in March of 2022, Emily hit what could have been a roadblock along her journey. She had an unexpected change in housing and had to make a last-minute move. Facing new apartment move-in costs, she was worried she would have to stop school because of the cost-of-living increase and childcare. That's when Emily learned about the Student Emergency Fund. **Thanks to the Fund, Emily was able to pay for childcare and successfully complete her classes.** 

With hard work and unyielding dedication, Emily graduated from The Evergreen State College in 2023 with a Master of Public Administration—a successful milestone that makes her smile grow even wider as she speaks about it.

Today, Emily works at Green River College in the advising center where she mentors prospective students. She sits on the Washington Low-Income Housing Alliance and wants to continue to serve as a rent stabilization advocate to ensure families have safe, affordable, and comfortable places to live.

#### SETH TOWNSEND, CLASS OF 2025 SUMMER UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP RECIPIENT

Seth came to Evergreen from the Chicago suburbs excited to study botany on a campus surrounded by temperate rainforest. Ask Seth about his passions, and he will tell you about his love for forestry, healthy ecosystems, and a sustainable future. "I found Evergreen while looking for schools in the Pacific Northwest. I've known this region to be famous for its political acts of community engagement and beautiful ecology, which I've always been attracted to," says Seth.

During the summer of 2023, Seth received a 12-week SURF fellowship to collect research samples in the field alongside his faculty advisor, Dylan Fischer, as part of a collaborative project shared by the Dept. of Natural Resources, the Dept. of Ecology, Evergreen, and WSU. The team is investigating how tree species use water and affect water cycles in temperate rainforests. Seth studied trees with sap flow probes and measured water stress in Douglas firs and maples. His findings show that trees face increased stressors in urban environments but can still fair well as long as water conditions remain stable. Thanks to donors like you, Seth will be credited as co-author on two scientific publications, which will help him excel towards his career goals. Following graduation, Seth plans to pursue a Master of Environmental Studies (MES) at Evergreen to advance his career goal of becoming an ethnobotanist.
