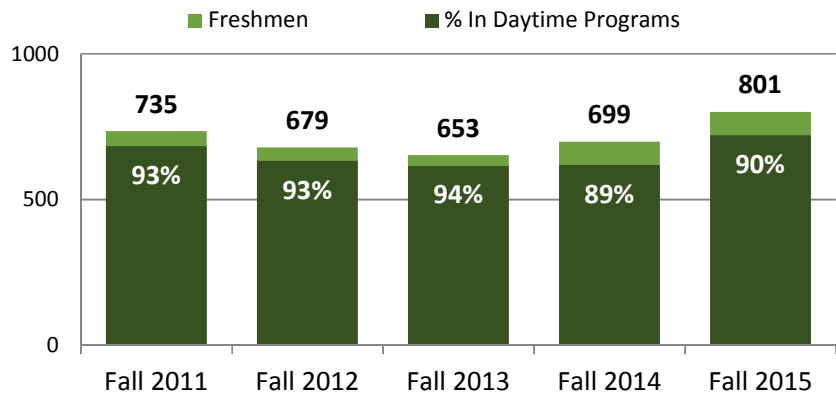

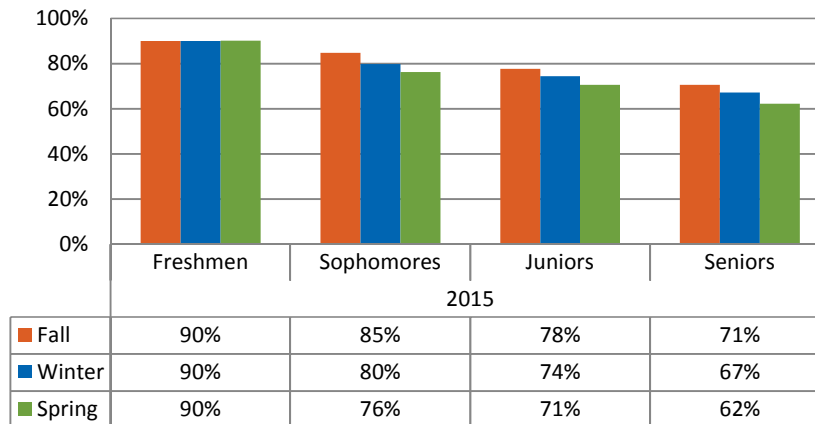
### Olympia Undergraduate Daytime Program Enrollment by Quarter/Year
