

**Summary: Fall-to-Fall Retention to Fall 2021**

Overall undergraduate retention to Fall 2020 rose two percentage points over the prior year to 74%.

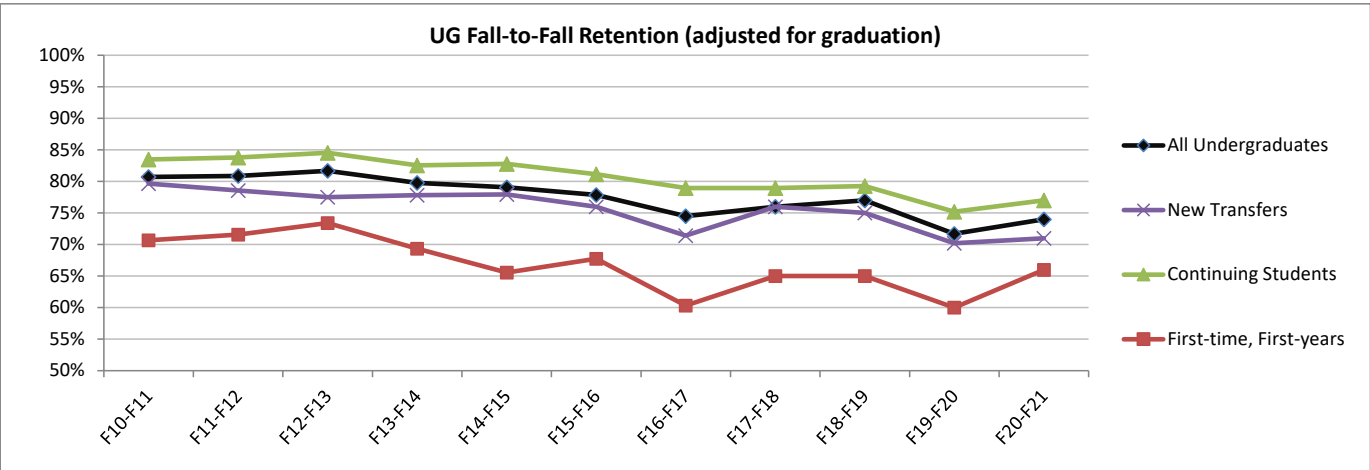
First-time, First-year retention rose six percentage points to 66%, the highest retention rate for First-time, First-years since 2015.

New transfer retention was similar to last year, gaining only one percentage point.

Number of students enrolled fall quarter who are enrolled the subsequent fall quarter (or who graduated in the interim year)

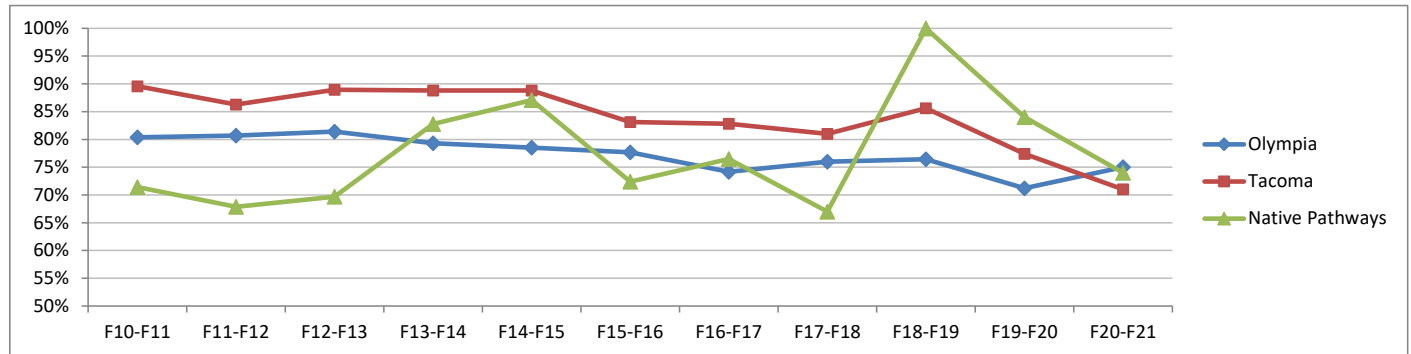

**Fall-to-Fall Retention Rates for All Undergraduates by Location**

Undergraduate retention rose from 71% to 75% in Olympia. Retention in Native Pathways and Tacoma dropped to 74% and 71% respectively.

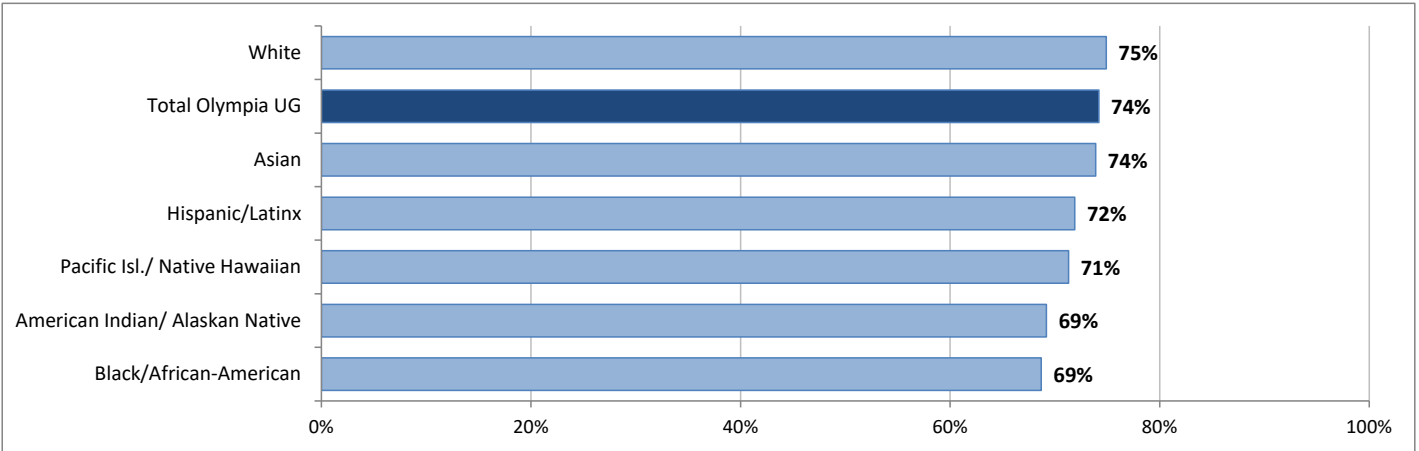

**Three-year Weighted Average Fall-to-Fall Retention for Undergraduates by Race/Ethnicity**

Combined cohorts Fall 18, Fall 19, Fall 20

Three-year weighted average retention by race/ethnic categories shows that Native American students (69%), and Black students (69%) are less well retained at Evergreen than the overall average of 74%.

**Fall-to-Fall Retention Rates for Undergraduate Students: Subgroup Detail**

Olympia undergraduate retention is lower for Veterans (72%), and first-generation students (71%) - compared to 75% for all Undergraduates. Students who are Below Poverty have a 76% retention rate, Federal Low Income students (below 150% of the poverty level) have slightly higher retention. Students who are neither low income or below poverty have a 73% retention rate.
