Background

Cell tower

- Last year, the college received two vendor proposals to install a cell tower on campus.
- We've long been interested in improving cell service on campus, and hear regularly from students and staff who are frustrated by poor cell service. For some, it's a safety issue.

- The SLUG (Space and Land Use Group) considered a large number of cell sites, using some criteria, before settling on the proposed site.
- The SLUG recommendation is coming to the president. He asked the group to collect community feedback. If the president endorses the recommendation, the Board would need approve a lease agreement.
- More information will be provided at during Friday's session.

Smoking shelter

- Since the removal of the smoking shelter by the CRC, students and faculty have reported problems with smoking in unauthorized locations around Sem II. Education and enforcement have not fully addressed the problem.
- The SLUG has approved a proposal to replace the CRC-adjacent smoking shelter with one at [a new site](#).
