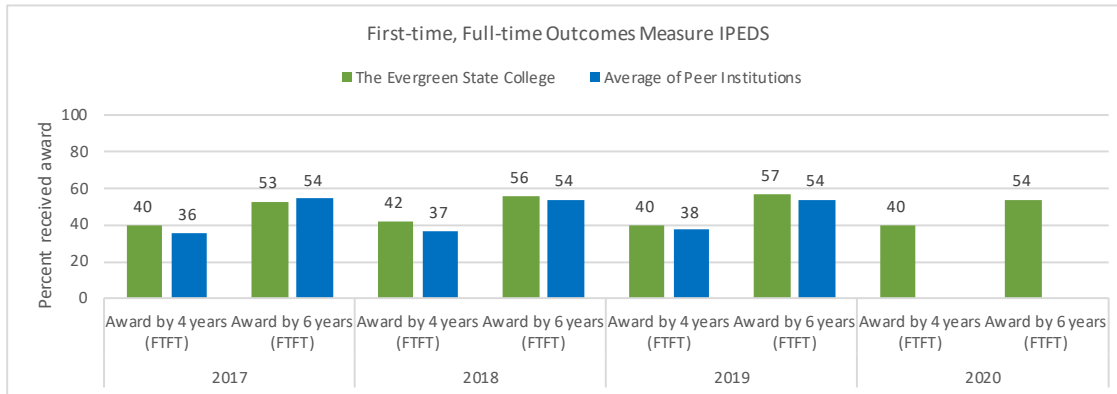


Figure 1. Evergreen’s 4 and 6-year IPEDS first-time, full-time outcome measures compared (through 2020) and peers (IPEDS, through 2019).

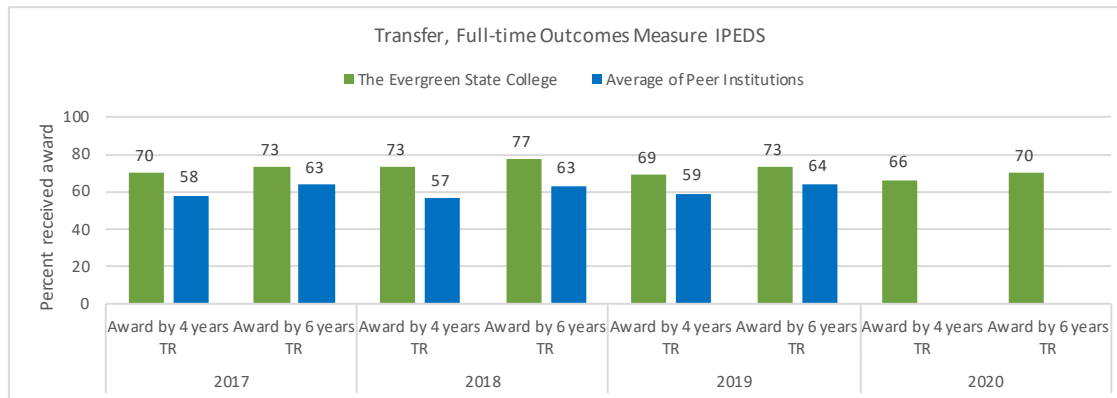


Figure 2. Evergreen’s 4 and 6-year IPEDS transfer (non-first-time) full-time outcome measures compared (through 2020) and peers (IPEDS, through 2019).

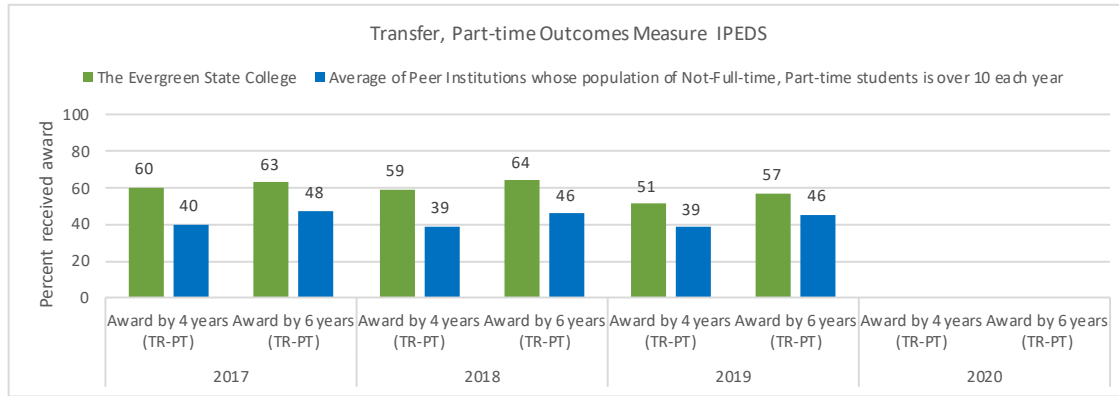


Figure 3. Evergreen’s 4 and 6-year IPEDS Transfer (non-first-time) part-time outcome measures compared (through 2020) and peers (IPEDS, through 2019, peer institutions whose population of transfer, Part-time students >10 each year).

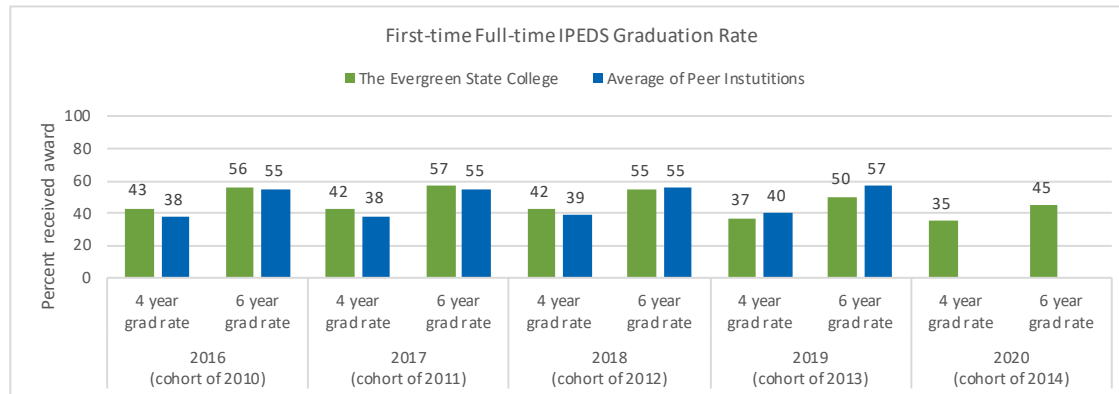


Figure 4. Evergreen's IPEDS Graduation Rate Survey (GRS150, first-time full-time students) 2010-2014 cohorts, measured in 2016 through 2020 respectively.

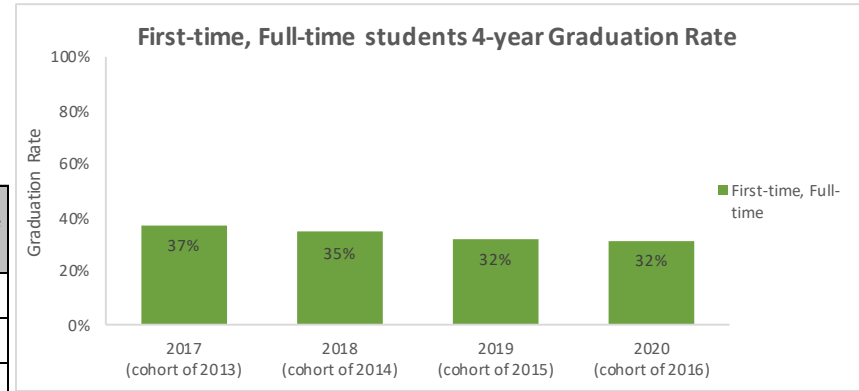


Figure 5. Evergreen's first-time, full-time students, 4-year graduation rate.

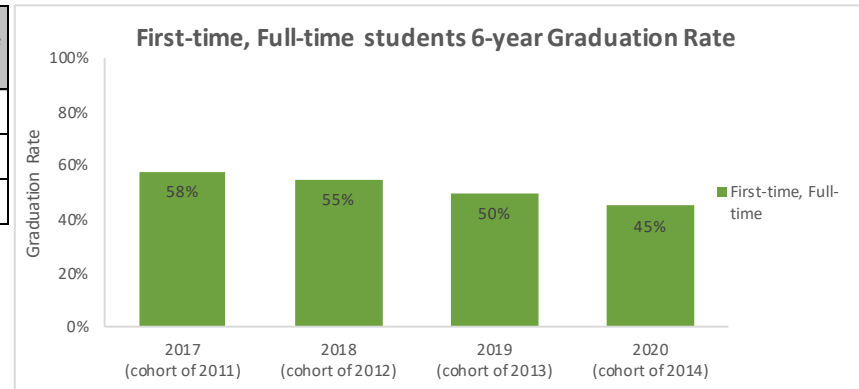


Figure 6. Evergreen's first-time, full-time students, 6-year graduation rate.

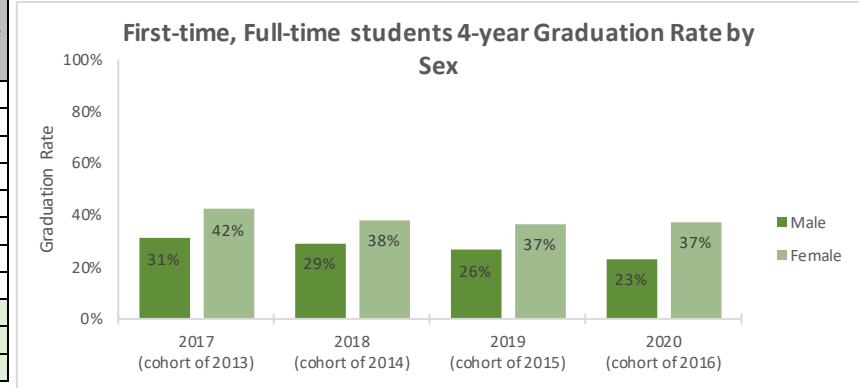


Figure 7. Evergreen's first-time, full-time students, 4-year graduation rate, disaggregated by (IPEDS) sex.

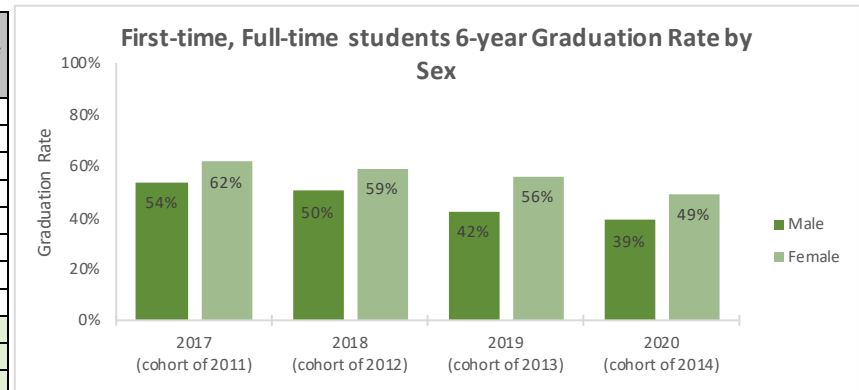


Figure 8. Evergreen's first-time, full-time students, 6-year graduation rate, disaggregated by (IPEDS) sex.

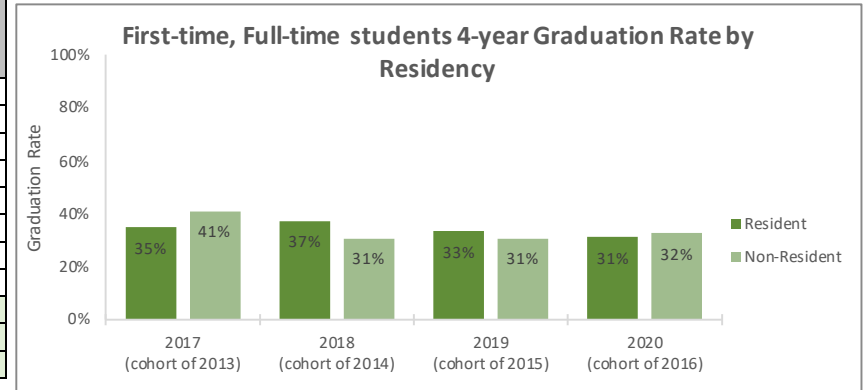


Figure 9. Evergreen's first-time, full-time students, 4-year graduation rate, disaggregated by residency.

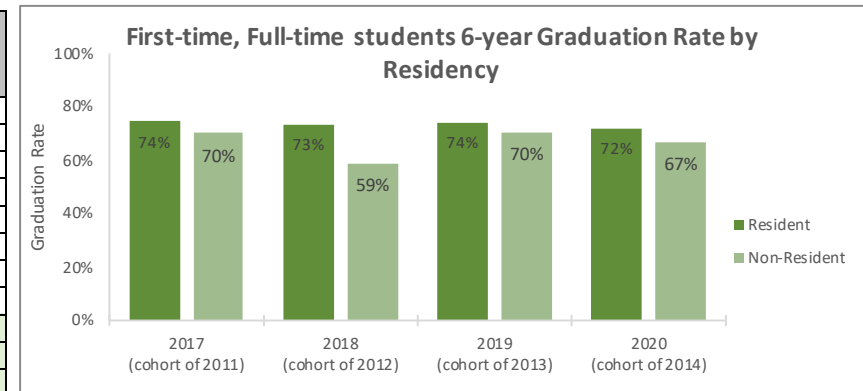


Figure 10. Evergreen's first-time, full-time students, 6-year graduation rate, disaggregated by residency.

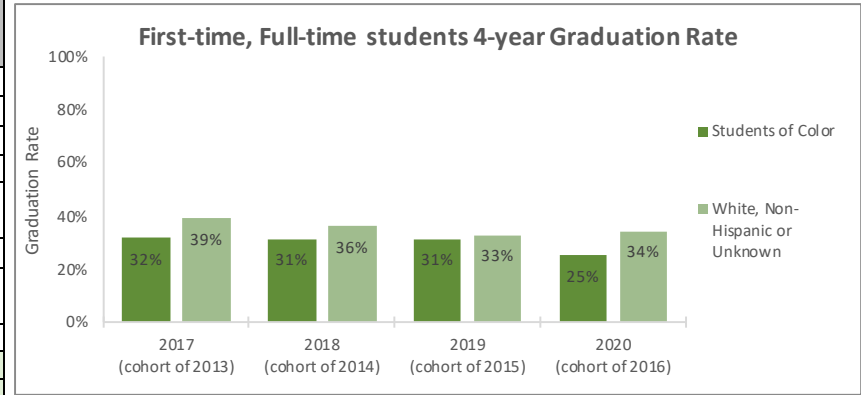


Figure 11. Evergreen's first-time, full-time students, 4-year graduation rate, disaggregated by IPEDS Ethnicity.

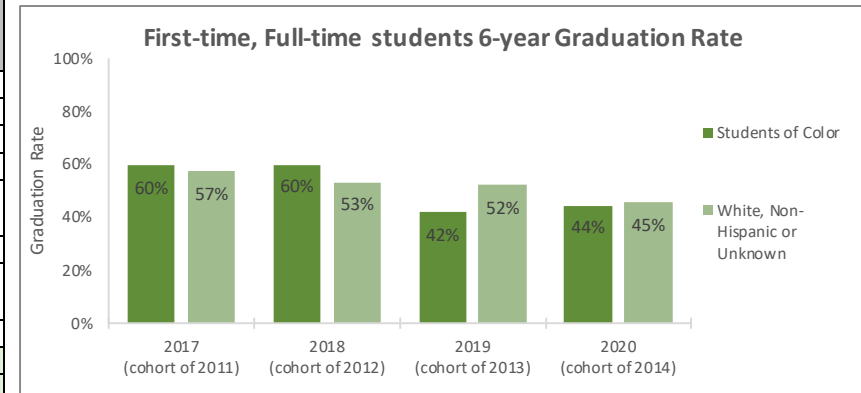


Figure 12. Evergreen's first-time, full-time students, 6-year graduation rate, disaggregated by IPEDS Ethnicity.

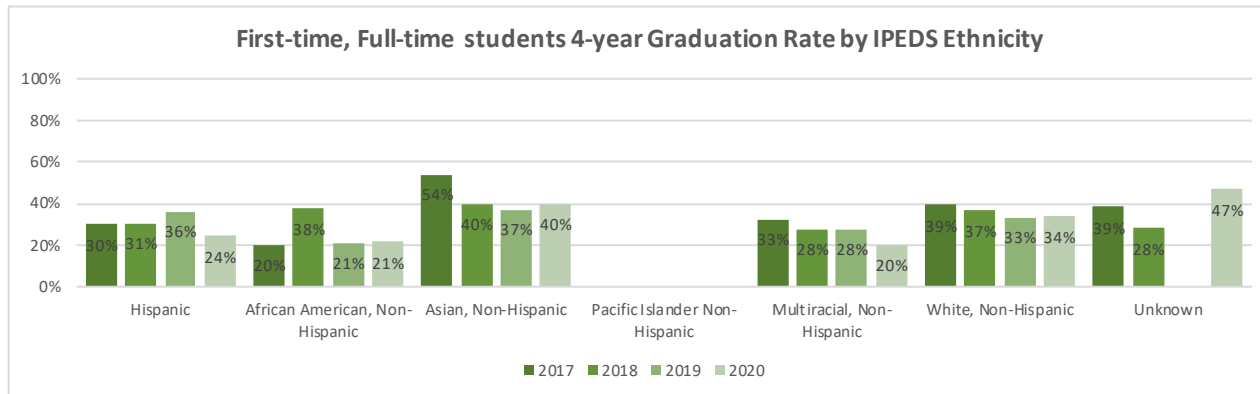


Figure 13. Evergreen's first-time, full-time students, 4-year graduation rate, disaggregated by IPEDS Ethnicity.

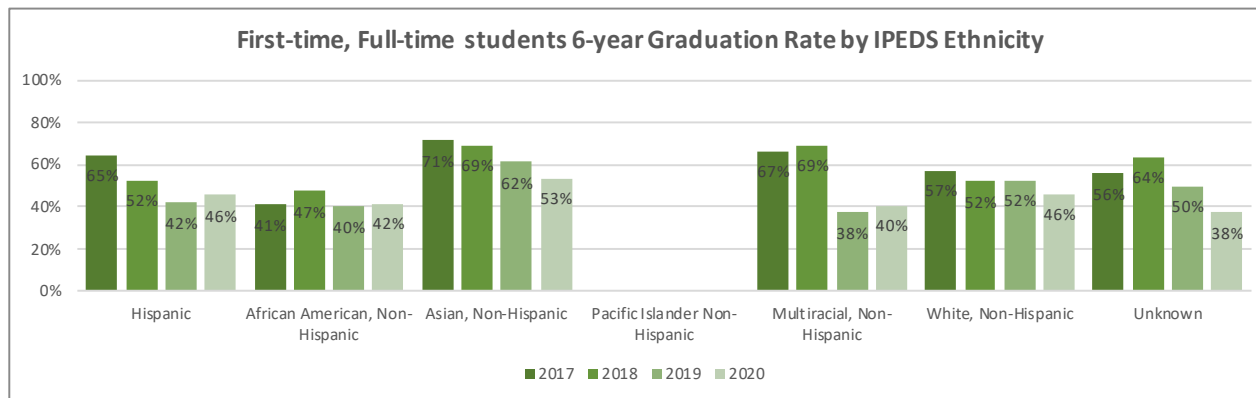


Figure 14. Evergreen's first-time, full-time students, 6-year graduation rate, disaggregated by IPEDS Ethnicity.

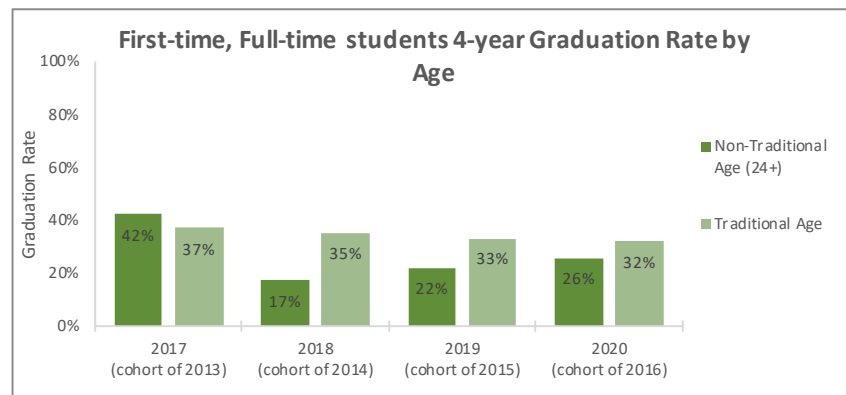


Figure 15. Evergreen's first-time, full-time students, 4-year graduation rate, disaggregated by age.

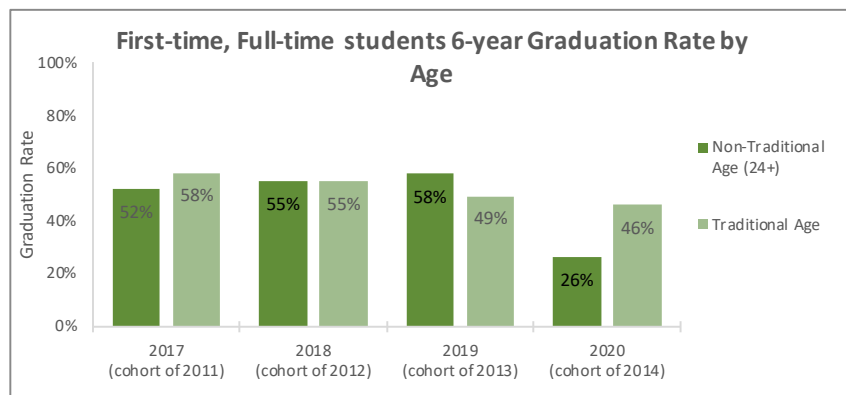


Figure 16. Evergreen's first-time, full-time students, 6-year graduation rate, disaggregated by age.

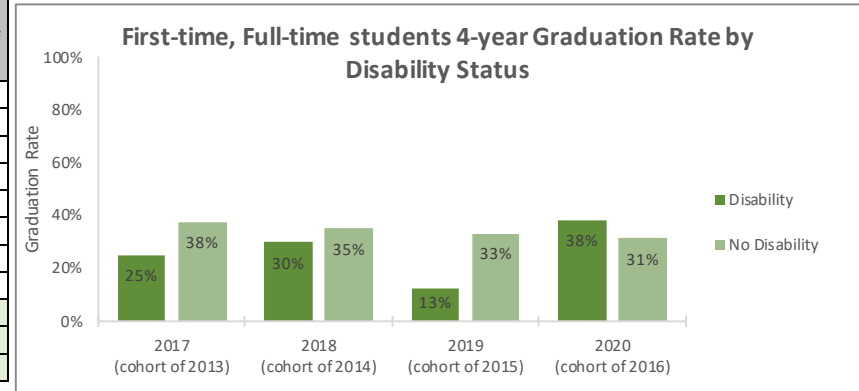


Figure 17. Evergreen's first-time, full-time students, 4-year graduation rate, disaggregated by Disability Status.

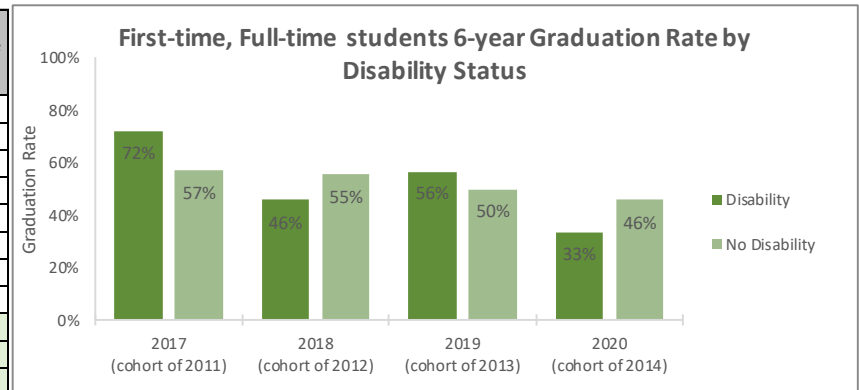


Figure 18. Evergreen's first-time, full-time students, 6-year graduation rate, disaggregated by Disability Status.

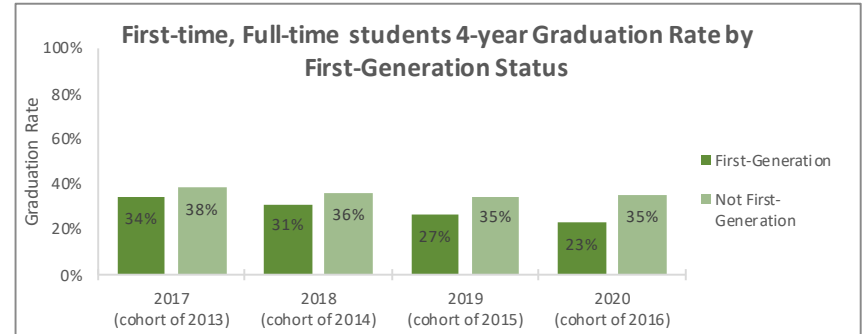


Figure 19. Evergreen's first-time, full-time students, 4-year graduation rate, disaggregated by First-Generation Status.

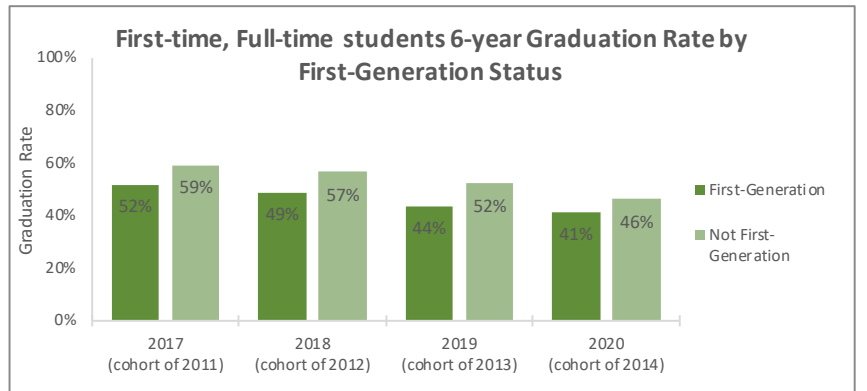


Figure 20. Evergreen's first-time, full-time students, 6-year graduation rate, disaggregated by First-Generation Status.

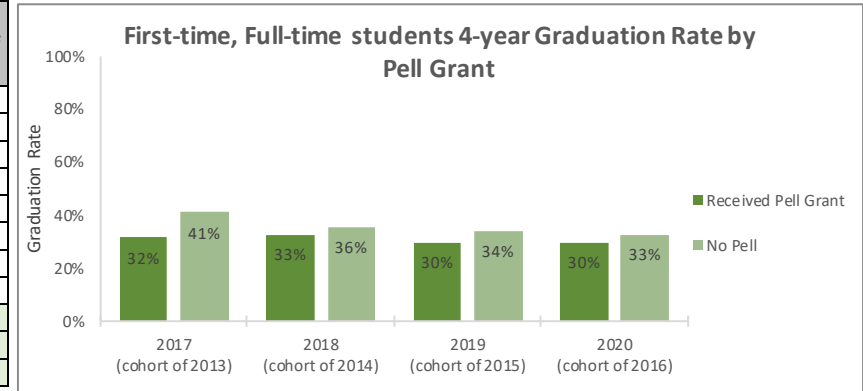


Figure 21. Evergreen's first-time, full-time students, 4-year graduation rate, disaggregated by Pell Grant.

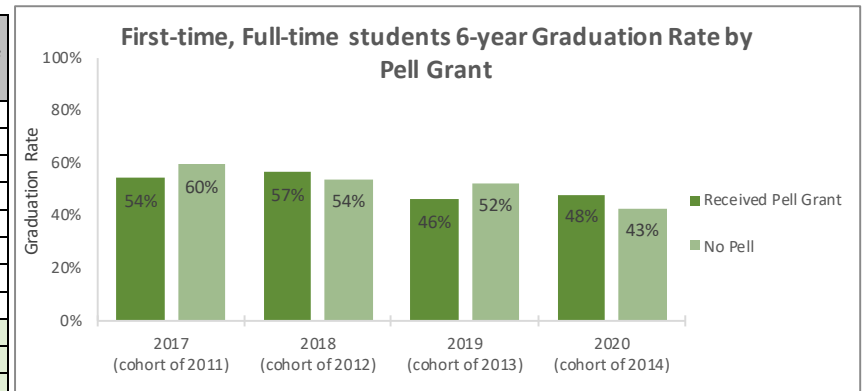


Figure 22. Evergreen's first-time, full-time students, 6-year graduation rate, disaggregated by Pell Grant.

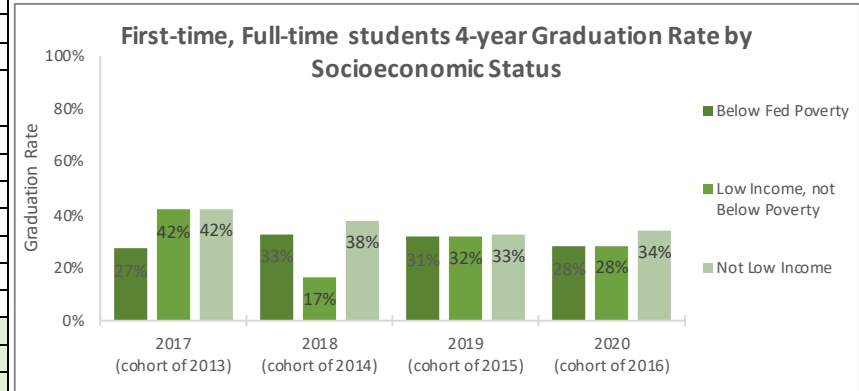


Figure 23. Evergreen's first-time, full-time students, 4-year graduation rate, disaggregated by Socioeconomic Status.

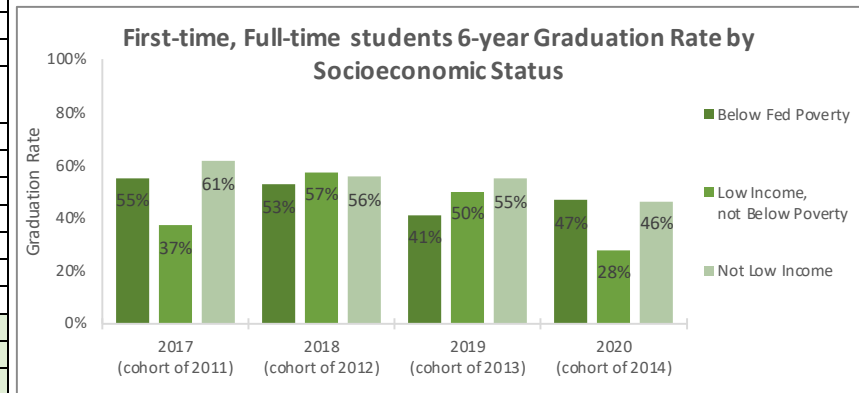


Figure 24. Evergreen's first-time, full-time students, 6-year graduation rate, disaggregated by Socioeconomic Status.

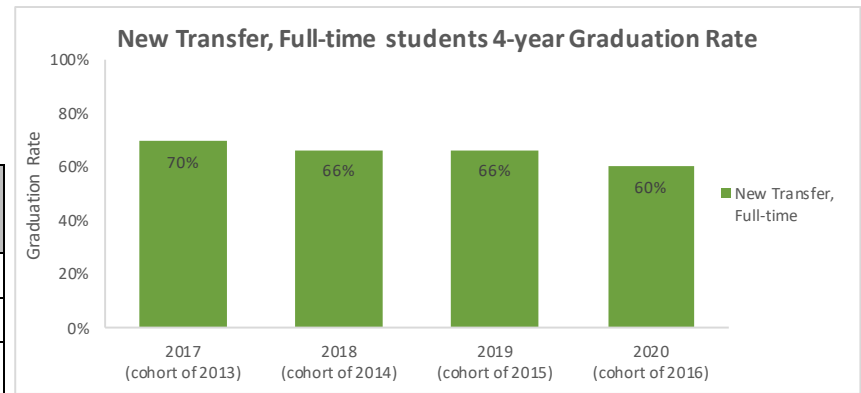


Figure 25. Evergreen's new transfer, full-time students, 4-year graduation rate.

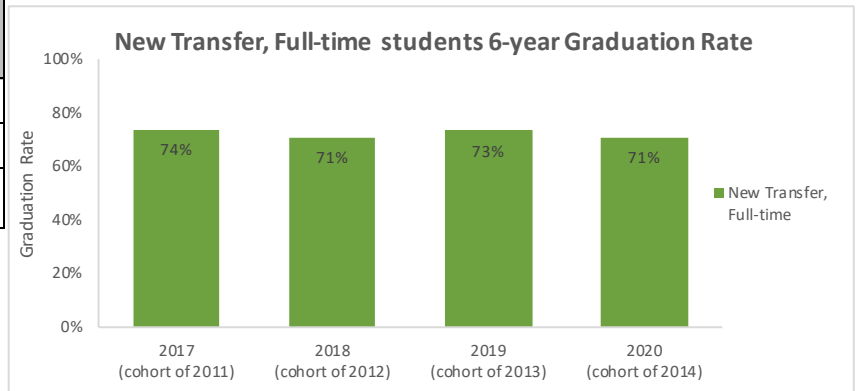


Figure 26. Evergreen's new transfer, full-time students, 6-year graduation rate.

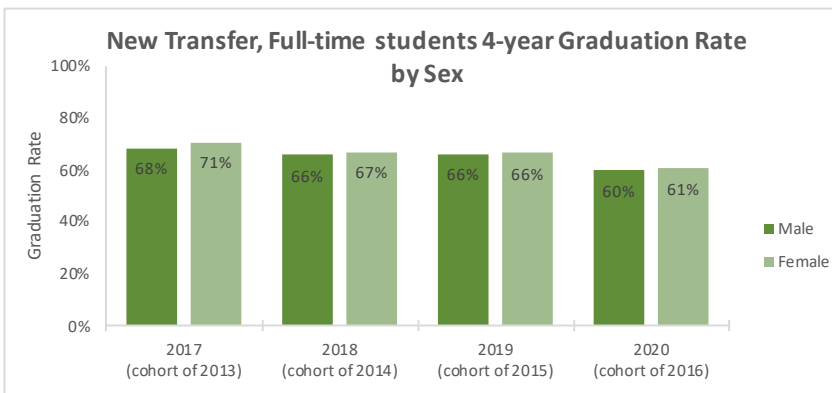


Figure 27. Evergreen's new transfer, full-time students, 4-year graduation rate, disaggregated by (IPEDS) sex.

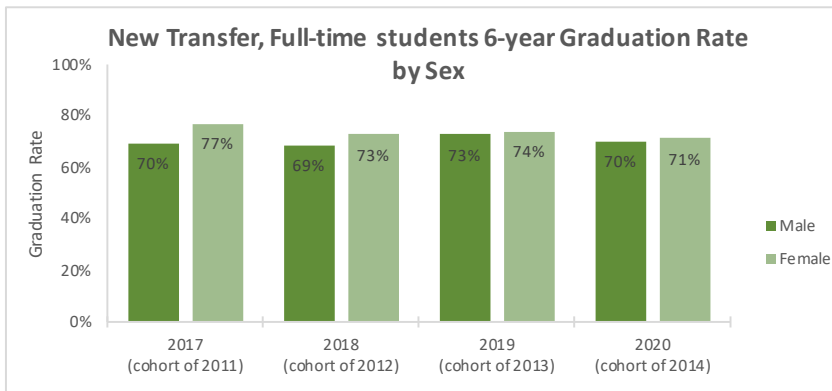


Figure 28. Evergreen's new transfer, full-time students, 6-year graduation rate, disaggregated by (IPEDS) sex.

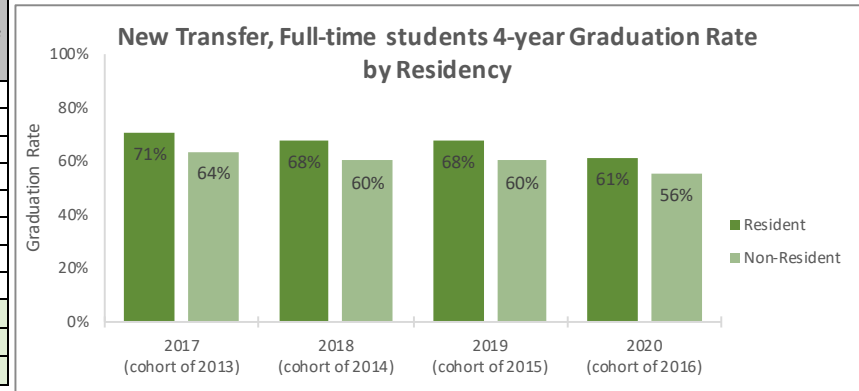


Figure 29. Evergreen's new transfer, full-time students, 4-year graduation rate, disaggregated by residency.

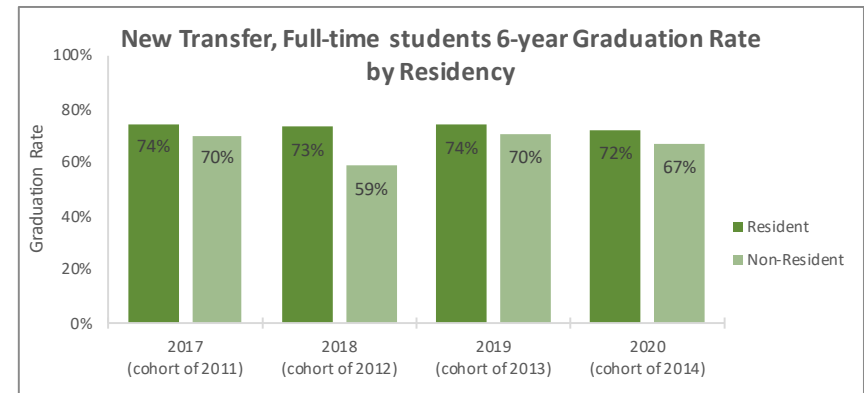


Figure 30. Evergreen's new transfer, full-time students, 6-year graduation rate, disaggregated by residency.

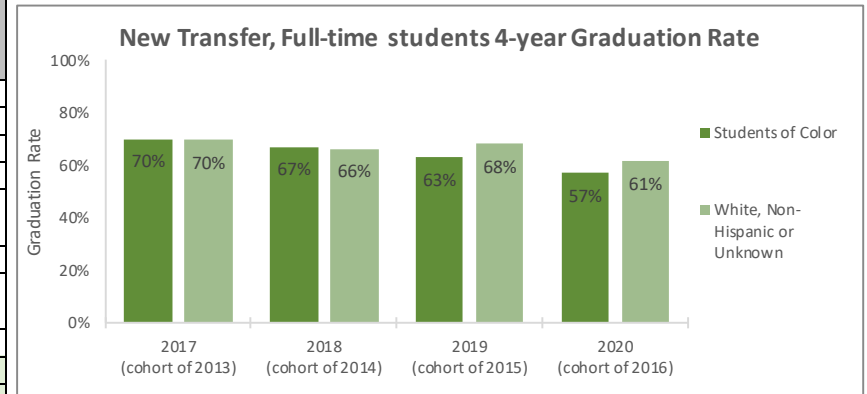


Figure 31. Evergreen's new transfer, full-time students, 4-year graduation rate, disaggregated by (IPEDS) Ethnicity.

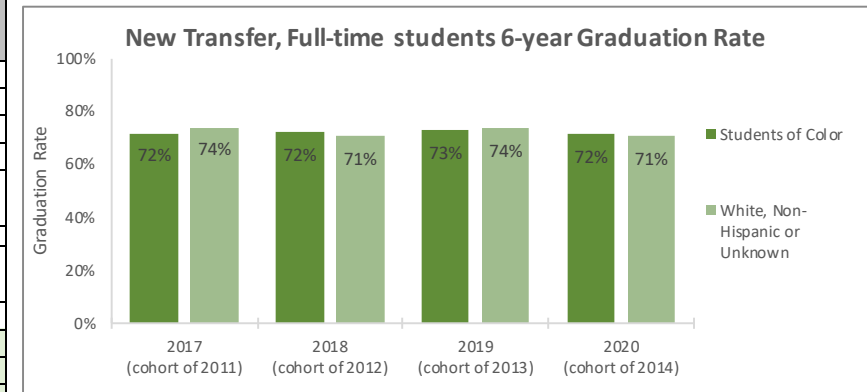


Figure 32. Evergreen's new transfer, full-time students, 6-year graduation rate, disaggregated by (IPEDS) Ethnicity.

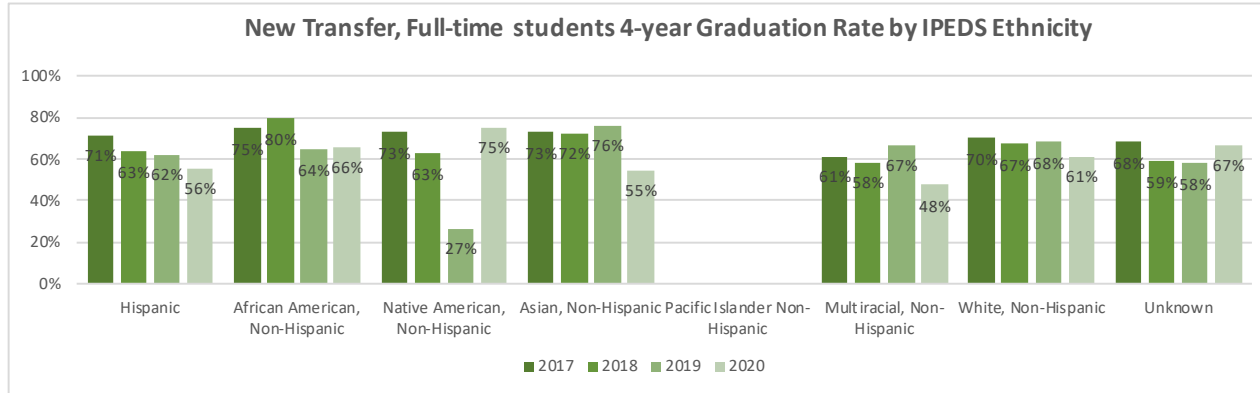


Figure 33. Evergreen's new transfer, full-time students, 4-year graduation rate, disaggregated by (IPEDS) Ethnicity.

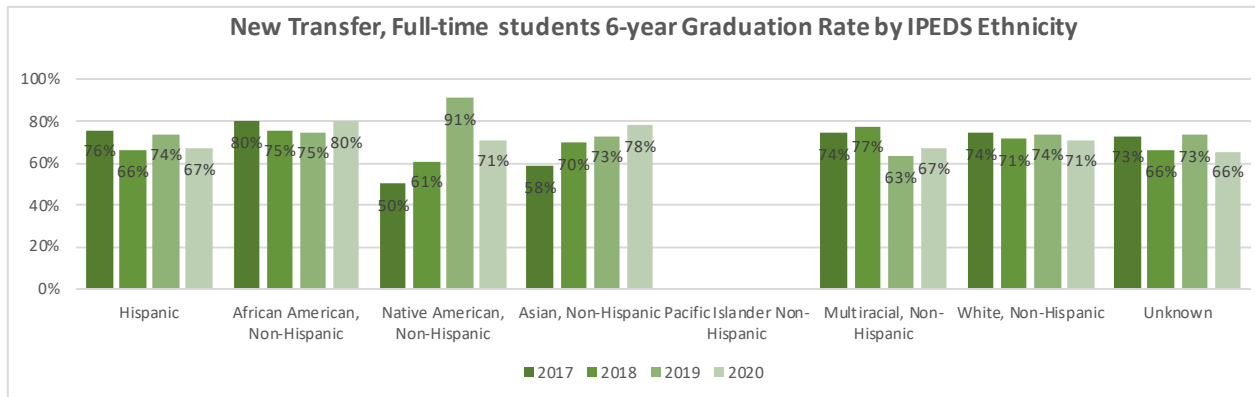


Figure 34. Evergreen's new transfer, full-time students, 6-year graduation rate, disaggregated by (IPEDS) Ethnicity.

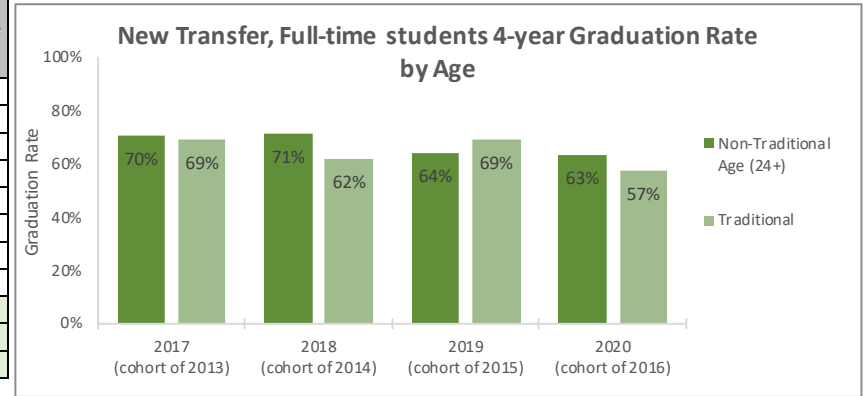


Figure 35. Evergreen's new transfer, full-time students, 4-year graduation rate, disaggregated by age.

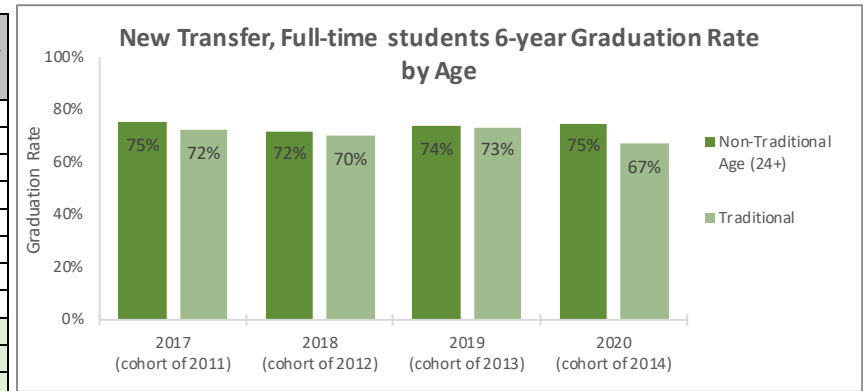


Figure 36. Evergreen's new transfer, full-time students, 6-year graduation rate, disaggregated by age.

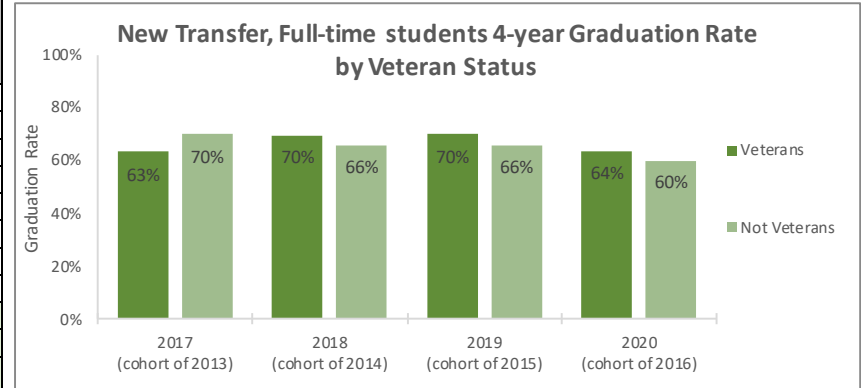


Figure 37. Evergreen's new transfer, full-time students, 4-year graduation rate, disaggregated by Veteran Status.

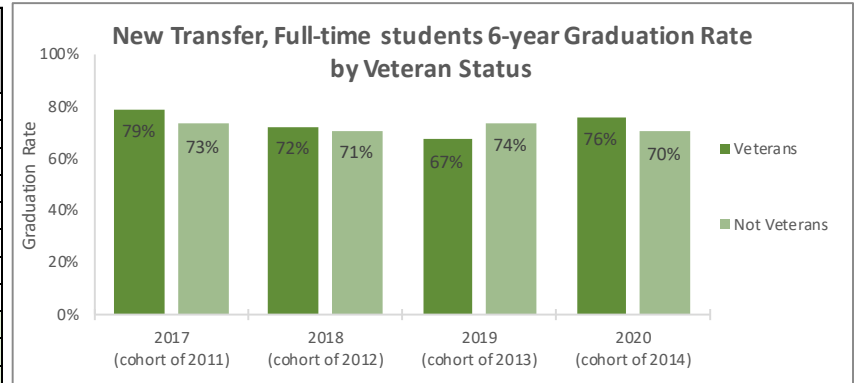


Figure 38. Evergreen's new transfer, full-time students, 6-year graduation rate, disaggregated by Veteran Status.

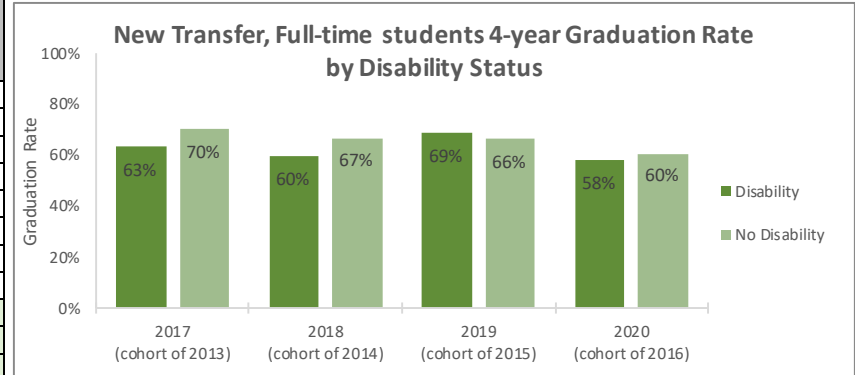


Figure 39. Evergreen's new transfer, full-time students, 4-year graduation rate, disaggregated by Disability Status.

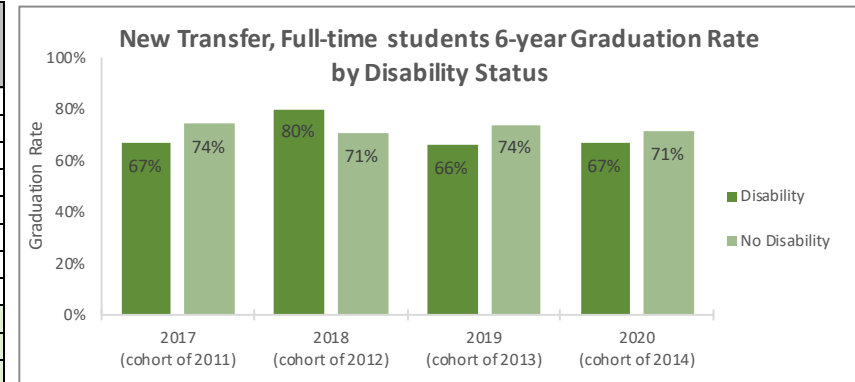


Figure 40. Evergreen's new transfer, full-time students, 6-year graduation rate, disaggregated by Disability Status.

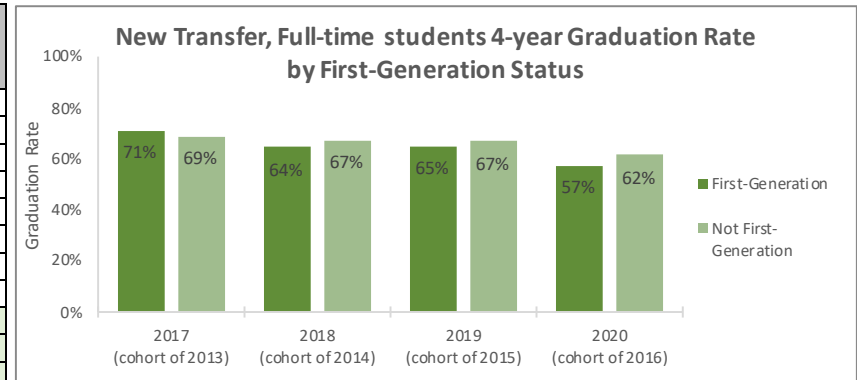


Figure 41. Evergreen's new transfer, full-time students, 4-year graduation rate, disaggregated by First-Generation Status.

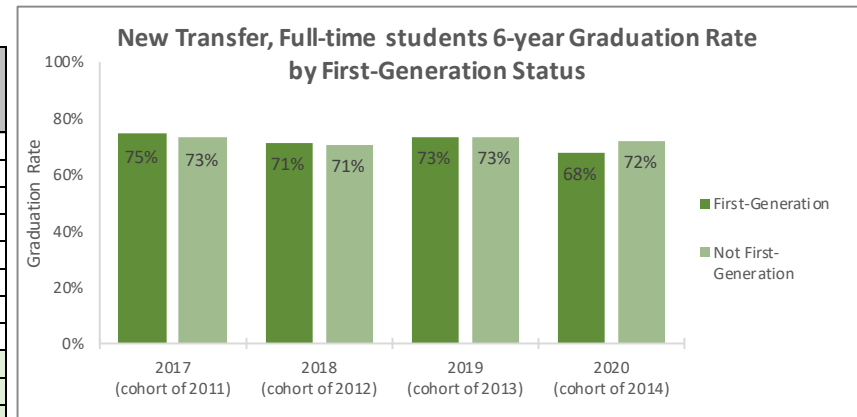


Figure 42. Evergreen's new transfer, full-time students, 6-year graduation rate, disaggregated by First-Generation Status.

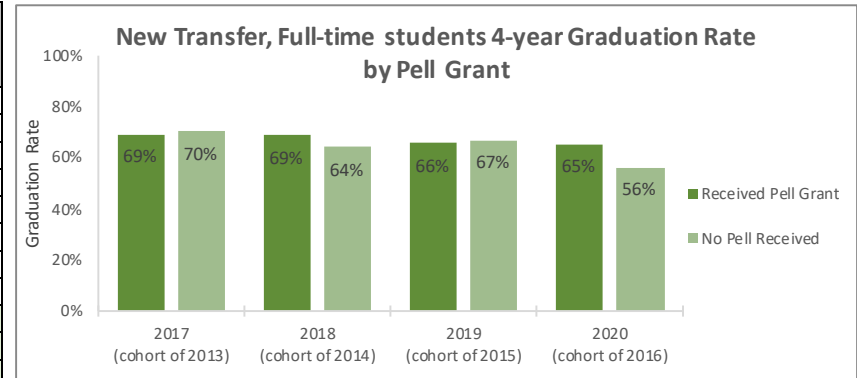


Figure 43. Evergreen's new transfer, full-time students, 4-year graduation rate, disaggregated by Pell Grant.

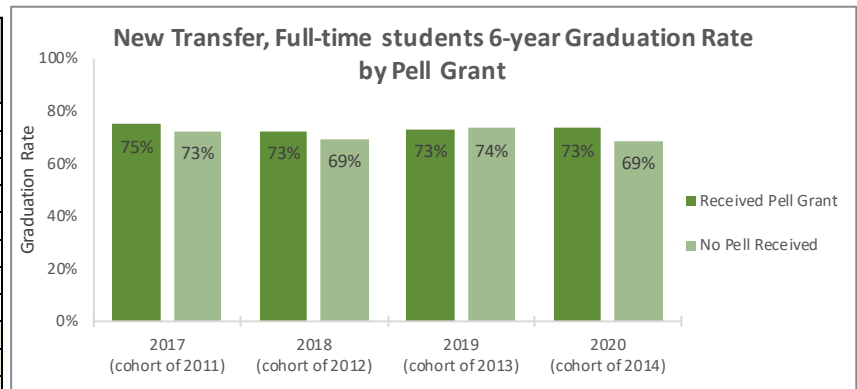


Figure 44. Evergreen's new transfer, full-time students, 6-year graduation rate, disaggregated by Pell Grant.

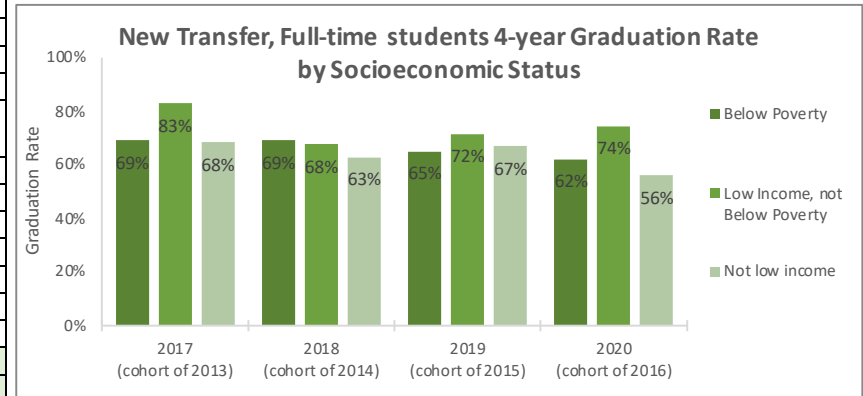


Figure 45. Evergreen's new transfer, full-time students, 4-year graduation rate, disaggregated by Socioeconomic Status.

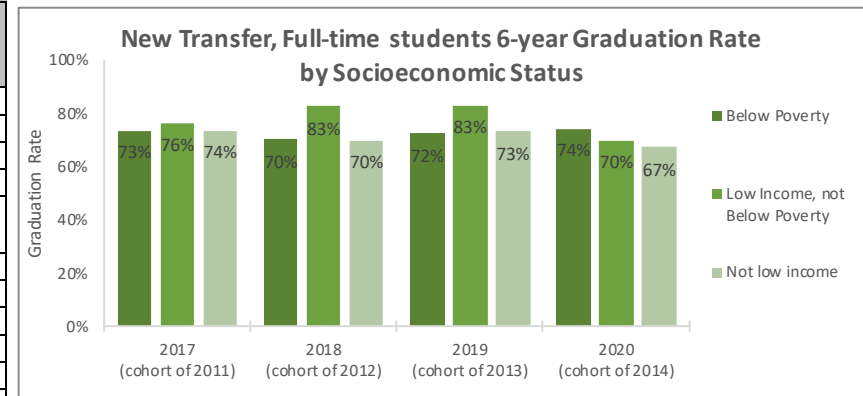


Figure 46. Evergreen's new transfer, full-time students, 6-year graduation rate, disaggregated by Socioeconomic Status.
