







Fall-to-Fall Retention Rates for First-time, First-Year Students

First-time, First-year men and women's retention diverged in Fall 2021. For many years the retention between the two has been very similar. However, this year retention for women rose 13 percentage points, while men's retention dropped 4 percentage points from the previous year. There is also a difference between students of color and white, non-Hispanic or unknown students.
