## Academic Mentoring Day - Winter 2018 Wednesday February 21, 2018

Winter quarter Academic Mentoring Day events took place in the Library building and Purce Hall. Winter Mentoring Day moved from Week 9 to Week 7 to insure that students could meet with faculty before the deadline for contracts.

The format was similar to the AY 16-17 year, with a welcome table at 1:30, the first sessions began at 2:00, and the second set of sessions began at 3:00. Mentor Council Chair Pauline Yu made brief welcome remarks at 1:40, pizza was available at 1:45. Faculty were on hand during both sessions to read Academic Statements in the library lobby.

Faculty presenters provided attendance counts for the sessions, which resulted in **estimated attendance for Mentoring Day sessions of 187**, which compares to attendance of 189 at the previous Winter Mentoring Day 2017.

Additional context notes: Evergreen Olympia Campus was closed in the evening of 2/20 and until 10 AM on 2/21 due to snow and icy road conditions. This was the first Mentoring Day event since the loss of the Mentor Council's administrative support position (which was first filled Dec. 2015); thanks to Kate McKinnon for stepping in to organize the event.
