

Programs by Number of Faculty 2006-07 to 2020-21 (Excludes Tacoma)

The table and charts below detail the trend in the number of faculty teaching in programs from 2006-07 to 2020-21. More than half (57%) of the academic programs offered in 2020-21 were taught by single faculty. This increase in single faculty programs was coupled with the decrease in two-faculty teams to 34% from 33% the previous year.





Programs by Quarters Offered (Olympia, Tribal and Grays Harbor)





Programs by Quarters Offered (Olympia only)

The tables below describe the trend of the number of quarters programs were offered, the quarters in which were they were taught, and the number of seats available per quarter from 2006-07 to 2020-21. The proportion of one-quarter programs in the curriculum was still, 59% for 2020-21. However, it is the first time in last five year that the proportion of one-quarter programs dropped to below 60%. The proportion of three-quarter programs increased by 5% this year while the proportion of two-programs dropped by 3%. Note that Reservation-based programs and Tacoma campus were not included in this analysis.


