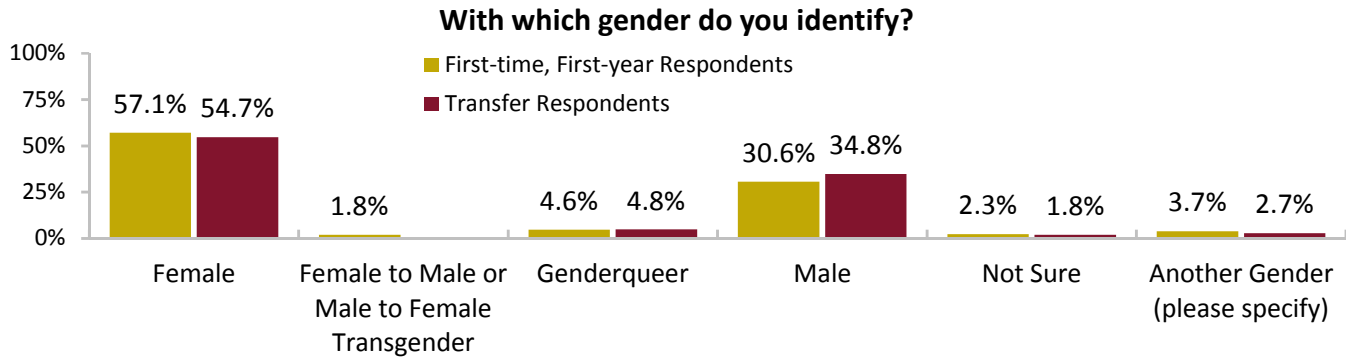


With which gender do you identify?

Students were asked what gender they identified with. First-time, First-year (FTFY) respondents are 57% female, 31% male, 5% genderqueer, 2% transgender, 2% not sure, and 4% another gender (listed below). 12% of FTFY students do not identify as male or female, or are not sure. Transfer respondents are 55% female, 35% male, 5% genderqueer, 3% another gender (listed below). 10% of Transfer students do not identify as male or female, or are not sure.
