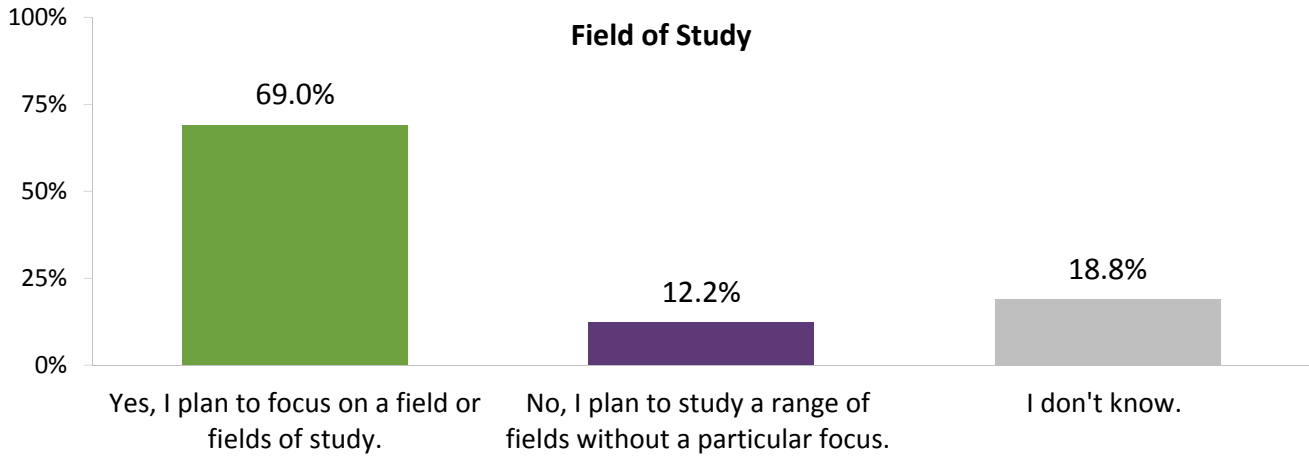


**Do you plan to focus on a particular field or fields of study at Evergreen?**

First-time, First-year students were asked if they planned to focus on a particular field of study; 69% plan to focus on a field or fields of study, 12% plan to study a range of fields, and 19% do not know.

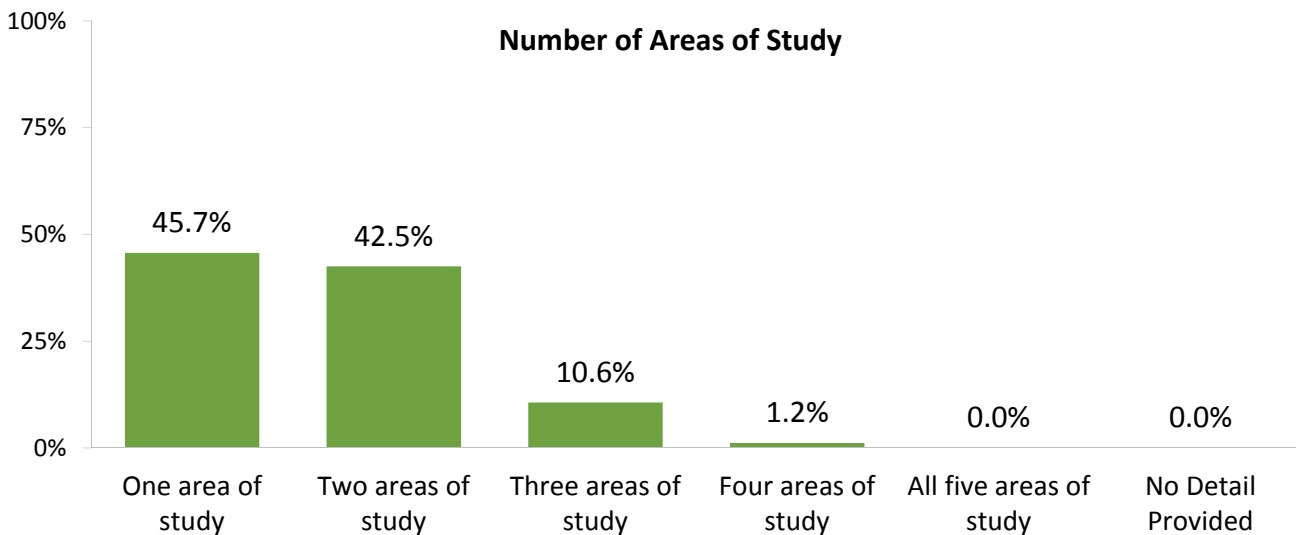

**Number of Areas of Study**







The respondents who plan to focus on a field or fields of study were asked to describe their focus. These open ended responses were categorized and are presented below. 46% of First-time, First-year respondents indicated they are concentrating on one area of study, 43% indicated two areas of study, 11% three areas of study, and 1% plan to study in four areas. No students were concentrating on all five areas of study or provided no further detail about their focus.



***If yes, describe your primary field(s) of study or concentration at Evergreen?***

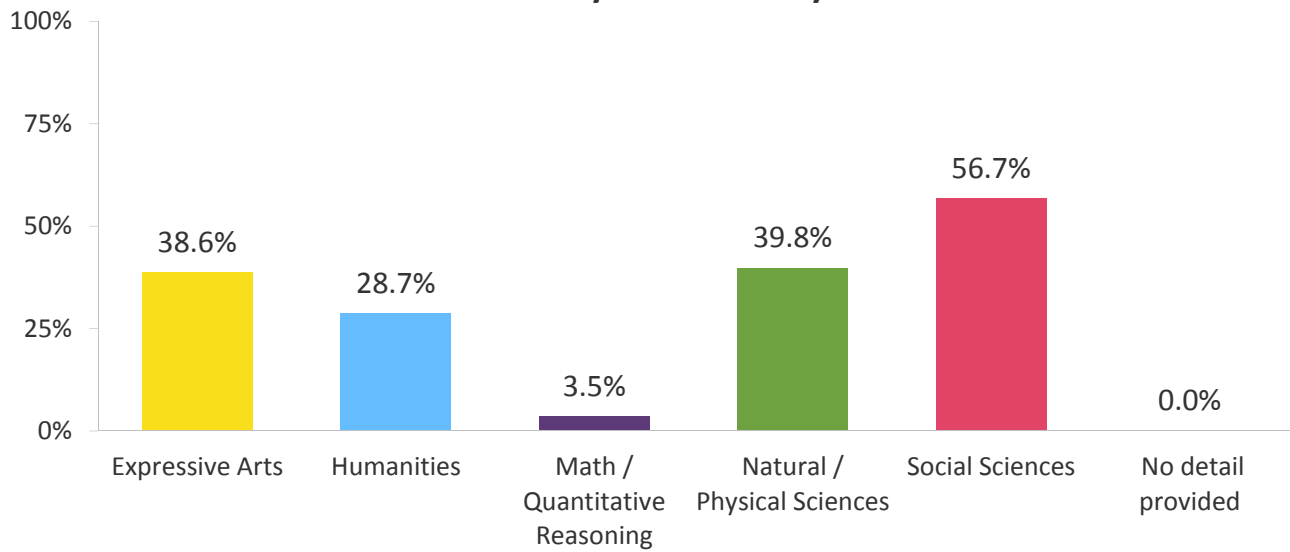
First-time, First-year students were asked to describe their primary field or fields of study at Evergreen. Of those students who plan to focus on a particular field of study, 39% plan to study Expressive Arts, 29% Humanities, 4% Math/Quantitative Reasoning, 40% Natural/Physical Sciences, and 57% Social Sciences. There were no FTFY students who provided no detail. Students were allowed to choose more than one field, so the categories will not sum to 100%.
