
Consent for the Collection and Processing of Personal Data for Use and Transfer between Evergreen and European Entities that are Party to the General Data Protection Regulations.

1. Your intended activities include being present in the United States or in European countries that are party to the **European Union General Data Protection Regulations** (EU GDPR). In accordance with the EU GDPR, The Evergreen State College (Evergreen), in its role as a data controller and/or processor under the EU GDPR, must have your explicit, affirmative, and informed consent before it can collect or process any personal data for a lawful reason. This includes, among other reasons: employment, official travel duties, admission and enrollment, inbound or outbound study abroad, internships abroad, online learning, etc. For information on how Evergreen uses personal data, please review the Privacy Statement at <https://www.evergreen.edu/about/privacy>. 2. **"Personal Data"** means any information relating to a natural person (or data subject) who can be identified, directly or indirectly, by reference to a name, an identification number, location data, or an online identifier, etc. It can also reference **"Personal Sensitive Data"** about racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs, trade union membership, genetic data, biometric data, health data, or sexual orientation or activity. While the use and transfer of personal sensitive data is limited, certain planning, health, safety, emergency, hiring, or legal situations may require this data. **"Data"** further references current or future data you provide to Evergreen or to an EU-based entity that is a planned part of your study abroad or travel experience, and the transfer of that data between EU-based organizations and Evergreen as a US-based organization.

3. Evergreen will collect and process personal data in accordance with its internal policies and with the regulations of the EU GDPR. These policies and regulations follow principles of fairness, lawfulness, transparency, purpose limitation, accuracy, storage limitation, integrity, confidentiality and accountability, and the protection of your privacy. This data collection is necessary for Evergreen to provide you with services, such as planning of study abroad programs, the processing of study abroad applications and required documents, enrollment in study abroad programs, academic services, arrangement of housing and transportation services, visa processing, and dietary and health services support, among many others.

4. Evergreen may process personal data without the data subject's additional consent under certain other lawful bases, including but not limited to: when processing is necessary to fulfill a contract that includes a data subject; for Evergreen to comply with applicable laws; and for Evergreen to aid in health and safety emergencies involving the data subject.

5. Personal data will be collected and processed only by persons who are responsible for the necessary activities associated with the study abroad program or official travel activities, and may be transferred between EU-based public and private entities and US-based public and private entities. Examples of public bodies include consular officers, public hospitals, public safety authorities, police offices, courts, and magistrates, among others. Examples of private entities include Evergreen, private universities and institutions, private hospitals and clinics, security supervisors, and insurance companies, among others.

6. Refusal of consent may make it impossible for Evergreen to carry out necessary planning, organizing, and enrollment activities associated with a study abroad program or official travel activities. As a result, it may prevent Evergreen from providing requested educational services, employment, participation in study abroad experiences, research, or other services to you.

7. You have the right to withdraw your consent for the collection and processing of personal data. You may do this in writing or orally. However, any personal data lawfully collected and processed prior to withdrawal of consent will not

be considered a violation of the EU GDPR. Additionally, as referenced in #6 above, withdrawal of consent may prevent Evergreen from providing further educational services from that point forward. 8. You have other rights under Articles 15 to 22 of the EU GDPR, namely right of access, right to rectification, right to erasure or “to be forgotten”, right to restriction of processing, right to data portability, and right to object. You also have legal rights and remedies against any breach of your personal privacy according to Articles 77 to 84 of the EU GDPR.
