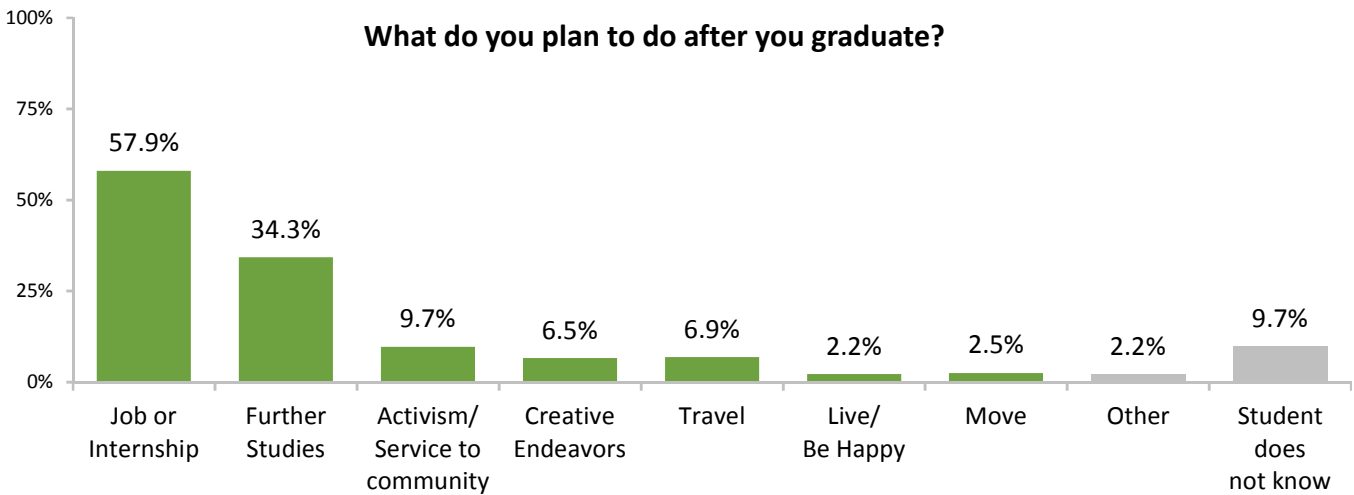


What do you plan to do after you graduate?*

Students were asked in an open-ended question what they planned to do after graduation. Responses from Transfer students were categorized and are summarized below. 58% of Transfer respondents plan to work after graduation, 15 plan to start or grow their own business or non-profit. 34% plan to continue with their studies, 6 transfers mentioned staying at Evergreen, 6 plan to go to the University of Washington. 12 students plan to study science, including 6 who want to go to into medicine. 8 plan to go into teaching, with the majority of those planning to get a Master’s in Teaching. 6 transfer respondents plan to get their PhD, but did not mention what they plan to study. 7% want to travel. 7% plan to do creative endeavors, including students who plan to write, make art, and perform music. 10% plan to be activists, most want to help the environment, but many plan to ‘help their community’, 3% plan to move, 2% expressed a desire to live/be happy. 2% of transfers plan to do something that could not be categorized (listed below) and 10% of students do not know what they plan to do after they graduate. The categories are not mutually exclusive, so groups will not add up to 100%.
