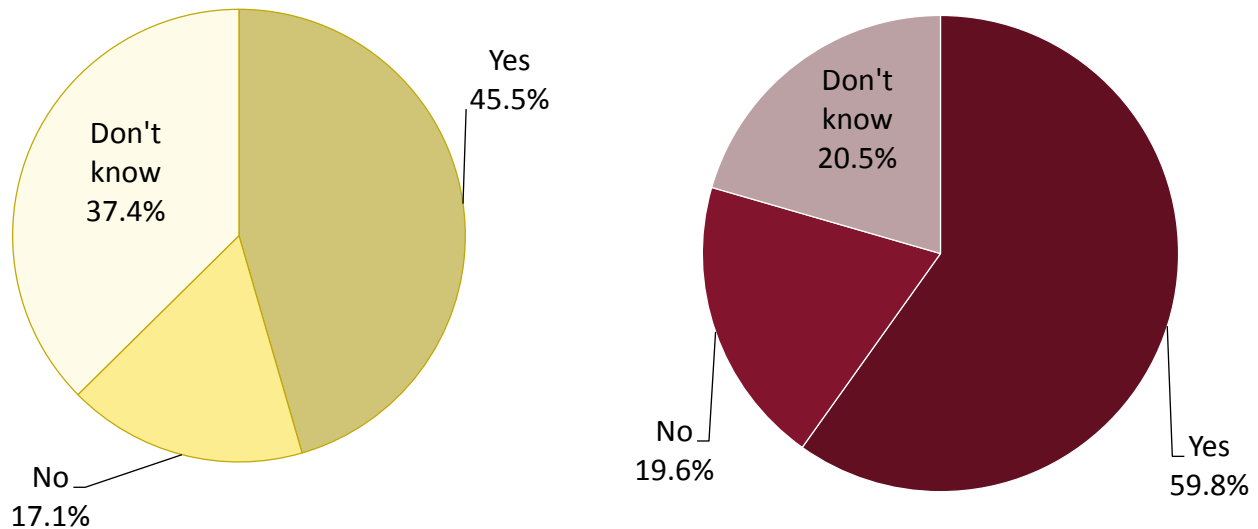


**Are you employed or planning to work fall quarter?**

46% of First-time, First-year respondents are employed or planning to work fall quarter. 37% didn't know if they were going to work fall quarter, and 17% did not plan to work. 60% of Transfer respondents were employed or planning to work fall quarter, 21% did not plan to work, and 20% didn't know if they were going to work fall quarter.

**If yes, how many hours per week?**

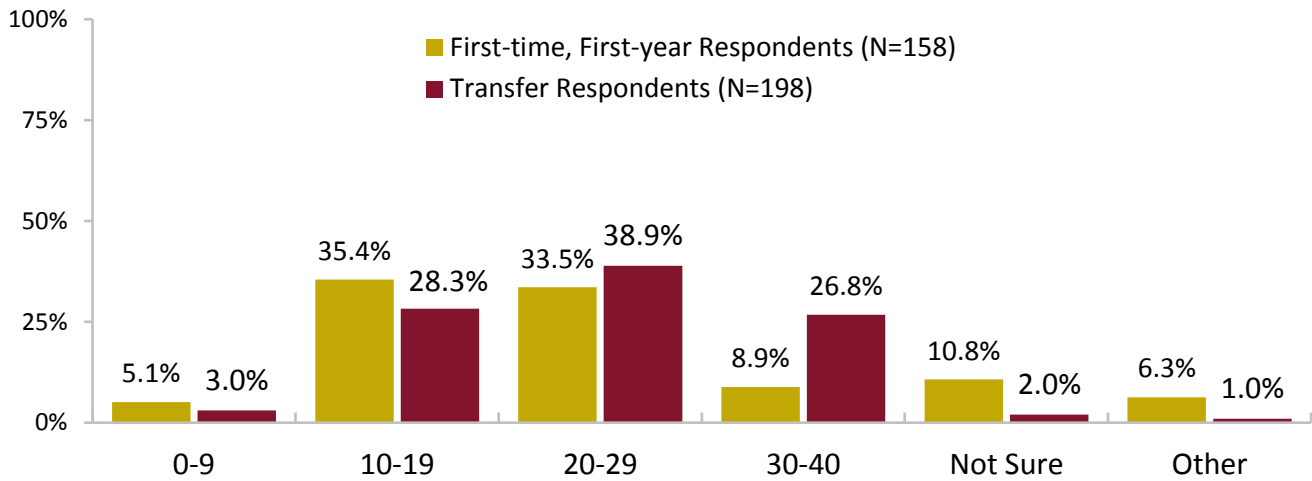
The following tables show students' responses to an open-ended question about the number of hours they planned to work, if they were planning to work fall quarter. These numbers only include those who were planning to work and answered this question.

Just over a third of First-time, First-year (FTFY) students are planning to work between 10 and 19 hours while attending classes at Evergreen fall quarter, another third are planning to work between 20 and 29 hours. 5% of FTFYs are planning to work fewer than 10 hours, and 9% are planning to work over 30 hours a week. 11% are not sure of how many hours they are going to work.

Transfer students are planning to work more hours per week than FTFY students. 39% of Transfer respondents are planning to work 20-29 hours, 28% between 10-19 hours, 27% between 30-40 hours, and 3% 0-9 hours, 2% weren't sure how many hours they would work, and 1% provided answers that could not be categorized and are listed below.
