For patients with insurance who need to be seen by a community provider:

- Locate your insurance card and see if you have a designated Primary Care Provider (PCP). If you do have a PCP, your next step is to contact them for an appointment. Bring your insurance information/card with you.
- If you do not have a PCP, contact the insurance provider – by phone or check on the internet.
 - 1) Determine if you need a Primary Care Provider (PCP) in order to use your insurance.
 - 2) Determine if you need a PCP referral for specialty care or if you can self-refer.
 - 3) From the insurance provider's web-list, select a PCP and/or specialist. You could compare provider options to our referral list and see if there is a local provider who accepts your insurance.
 - 4) Contact them for an appointment and be sure to bring your insurance information/card with you.
