


What do you plan to do after you graduate?

Students were asked, in an open-ended question, about their plans for after college. Responses from First-time, First-year (FTFY) students were categorized and are summarized below. *The categories below are not mutually exclusive, so they will not add up to 100%.*

58% of First-Time, First-Year students plan to get a job or internship after graduation, of those, the most common fields of work mentioned were Visual Arts/Media (17%), Education (15%), Psychology/Social Work (13%), and Natural and Physical Sciences (10%), some students mentioned working in writing (4%) or in other fields (14%). 27% of students who plan to get a job or internship after graduating did not specify what field they plan to work in. 19% of FTFYs plan to continue with their studies, most (55%) did not specify what they want to study, of those who did, the most frequently mentioned field of study was Natural, Physical and Health Sciences (4). 10% of FTFYs plan to be activists or serve their community, 6 of those mentioned serving through the Peace Corps or AmeriCorps. 7% of FTFYs plan to travel after graduation, 4% simply want to live and be happy, 3% plan to move, 2% plan to take on creative endeavors, 1% of FTFYs plan to do something that could not be categorized and 18% of FTFY students do not know what they plan to do after they graduate.




FTFY What do you plan to do after you graduate?
