


### What do you plan to do after you graduate?

Students were asked, in an open-ended question, about their plans for after college. Responses from Transfer students were categorized and are summarized below. *The categories below are not mutually exclusive, so they will not add up to 100%.*

63% of Transfer students plan to get a job after graduation, of those students, about 50% want to pursue careers in Natural and Physical Sciences, Education, Visual Arts/Media, or Psychology/Social Work, 24% want to pursue careers in Technology, Marketing/Business, Legal, or another field, the rest know they want to work after graduation, but did not specify what field they want to work in—of these, 7 mentioned simply wanting to work somewhere enjoyable. 29% of Transfer students plan to continue with their studies, most did not specify what they want to study, among those who did, the most frequently mentioned fields of study include Education (5), Psychology and/or Social work (5), and Physical Sciences (5). 12% of Transfers plan to be activists or serve their community, students mentioned environment/sustainability, implementing political change, and helping low-income populations. 8% of Transfers plan to take on creative endeavors, including writing, art, and creating/performing music. 5% plan to travel, 3% simply want to live or be happy, and 5% of students do not know what they plan to do after they graduate.





**Job or Internship -- *Natural and Physical Sciences***
