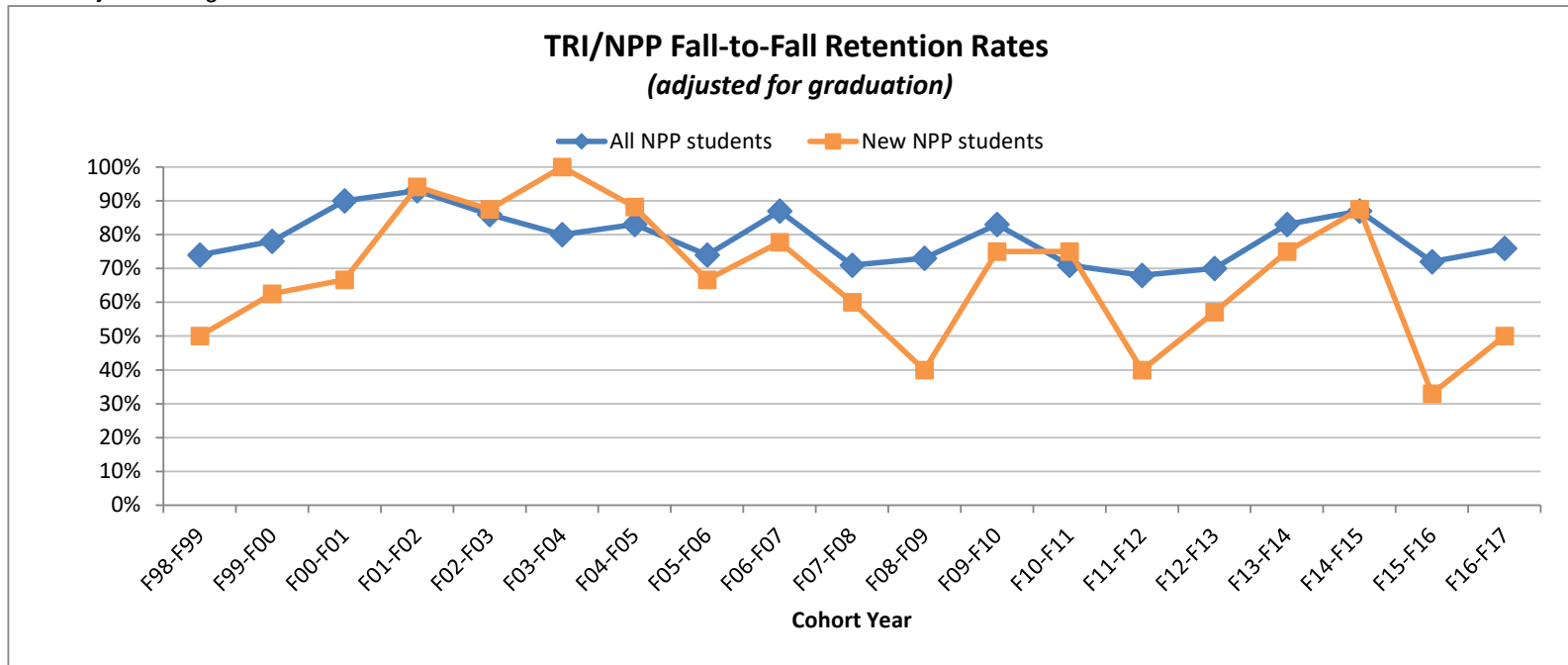

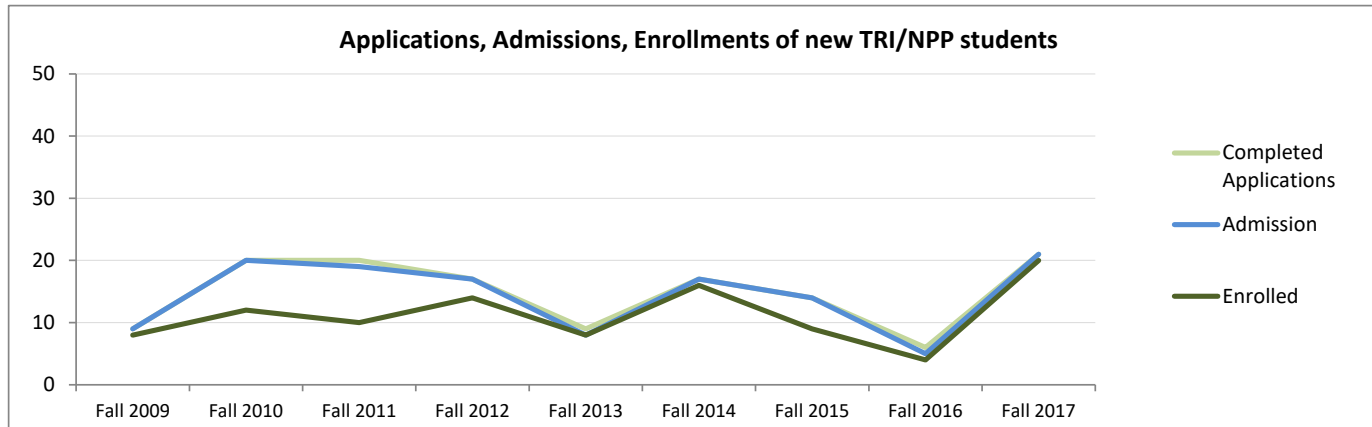

Native Pathways and Tribal Sites: Program Enrollment Detail

Fall Quarter Headcounts

The partnership with University Center of North Puget Sound (UCNPS) for the Tulalip Tribal program began winter quarter 2008, (then inactivated in fall 2014 due to low enrollment). Tulalip program headcount are excluded from all data in this summary, since enrollments belong to UCNPS, not Evergreen. Evergreen's Tribal: Reservation-based program with the Chehalis Tribe opened in Fall 2014 and was inactivated in Fall 2016. The evolution of Tribal: Reservation-based Programs into Native Pathways Programs launched in Fall 2017, and it included the first urban site on Tacoma campus and a weekend hybrid program at Olympia Longhouse.

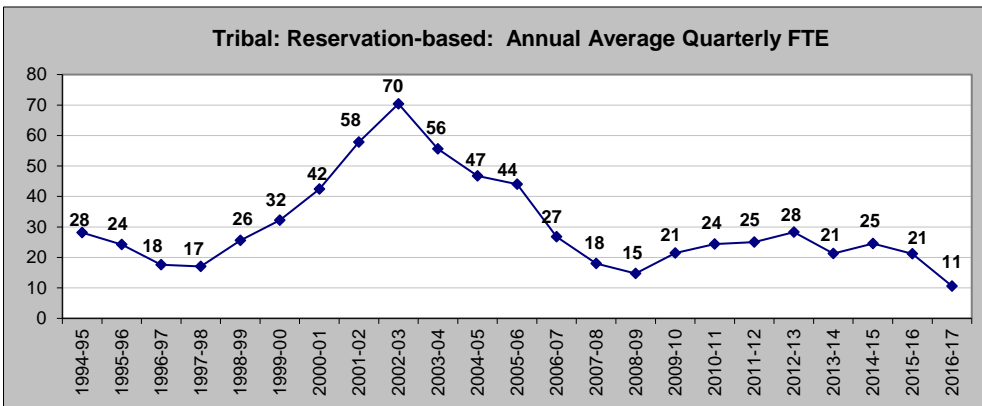

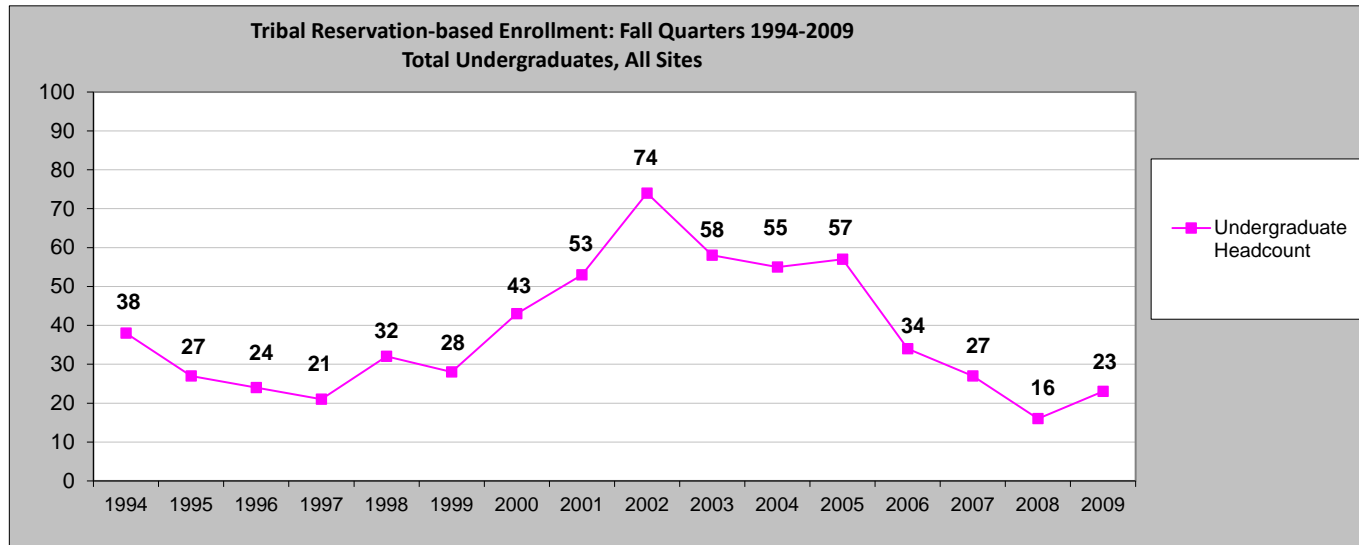
