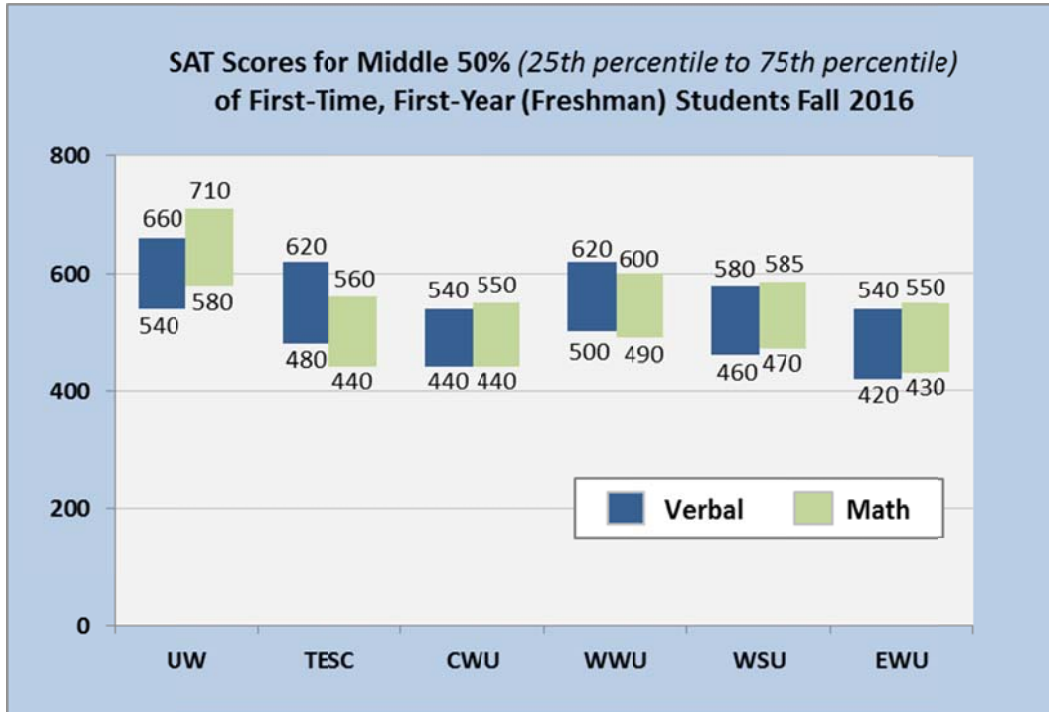


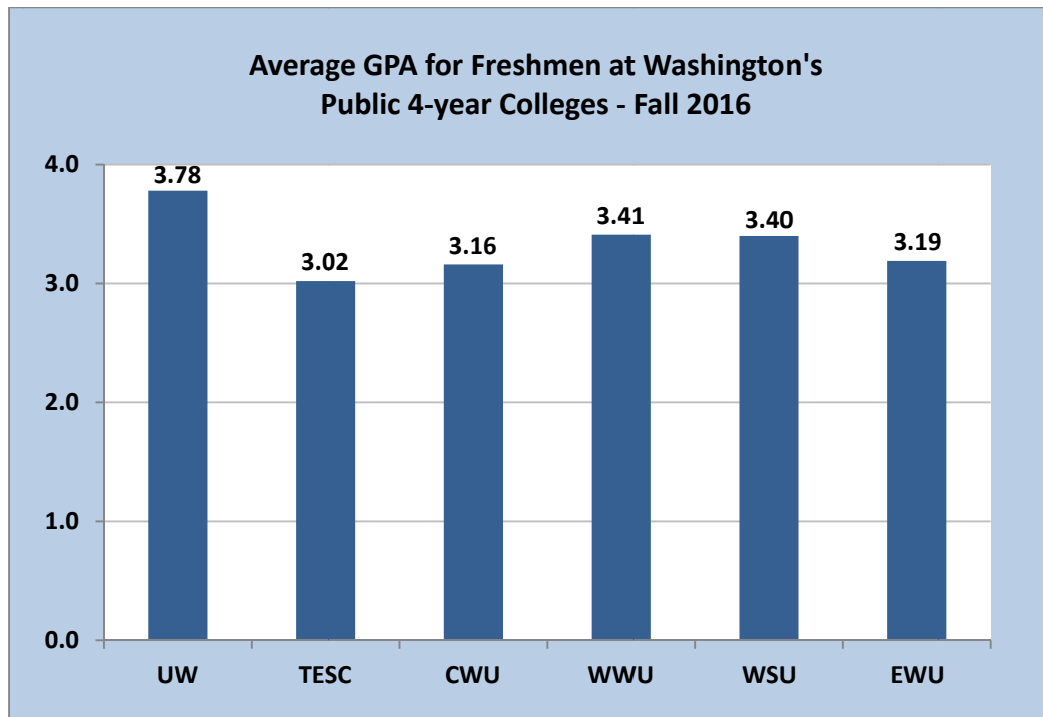
SAT Scores and GPAs for Entering Freshmen at Washington’s Public Baccalaureate Institutions

Of freshmen entering Washington’s six public baccalaureate institutions fall 2016, Evergreen’s middle 50% scored lower on the verbal SAT than those at the UW, comparably to those at WWU, and higher than those at CWU, WSU, and EWU. Evergreen freshmen consistently score at or near the top of this peer group on the verbal SAT. On the math SAT, Evergreen’s middle 50% scored higher than new freshmen at CWU and EWU and lower than freshmen at UW, WWU, and WSU. This ranking is also fairly consistent over time, reflecting the reality that as a liberal arts college Evergreen may be more of a magnet for students whose verbal skills are strong relative to their quantitative skills.

The average GPA of entering freshmen at Evergreen is historically at or below that of entering freshmen at our peer institutions.

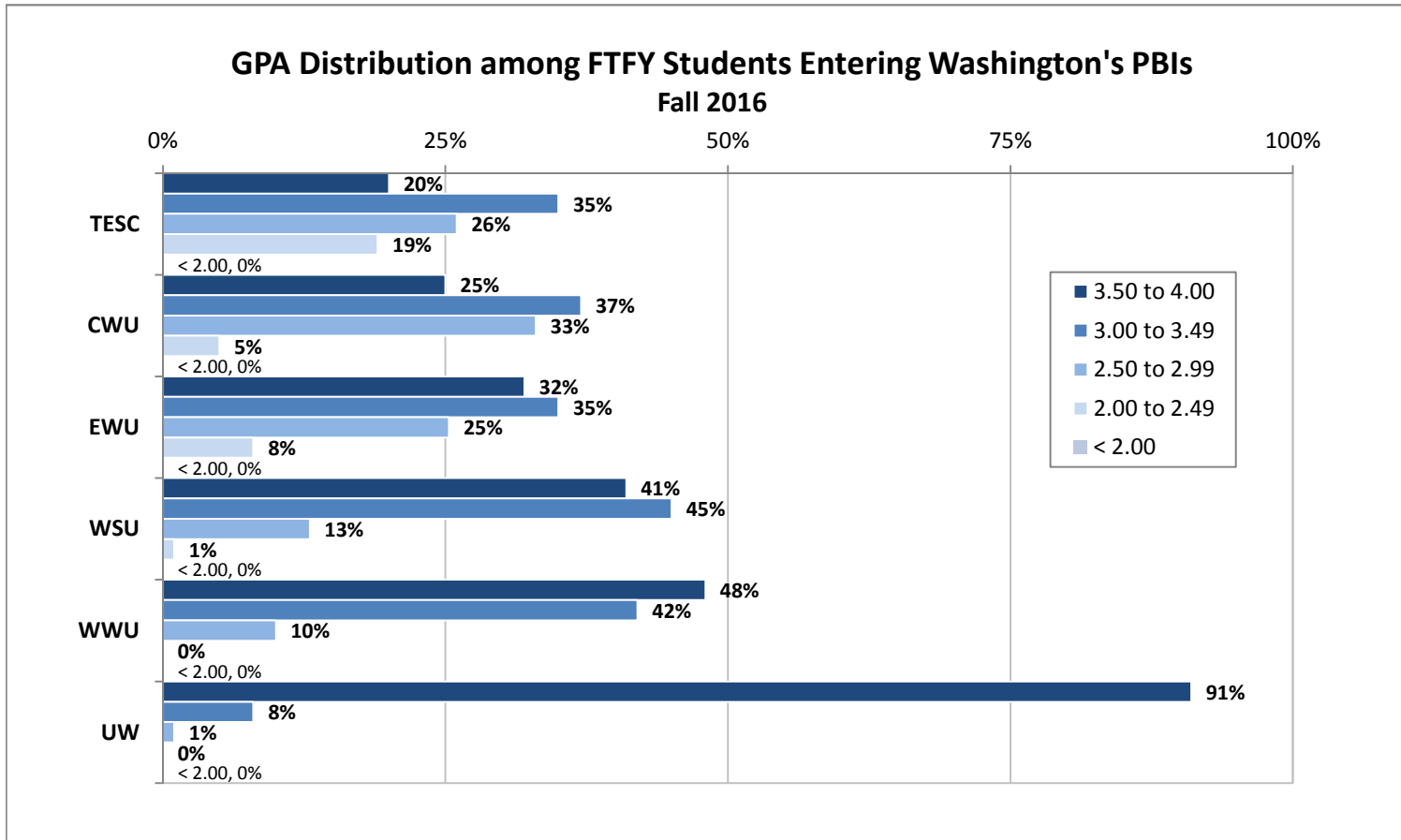

GPA Distribution among First-Time, First-Year Students at Washington's Public Baccalaureate Institutions

Evergreen's First-Time, First-Year (FTFY) students historically have the lowest mean GPA of students entering Washington's six Public Baccalaureate Institutions (PBIs). Analysis of the distribution of GPAs across ranges revealed that in fall 2016 Evergreen had the lowest percentage of incoming students with a GPA between 3.50 and 4.00 and the highest percentage of students with GPAs between 2.00 and 2.49. However, the percentage of entering students with GPAs in the middle categories (3.00 to 3.49 and 2.50 to 2.99) were notably similar among FTFYs at Evergreen, Central Washington University, and Eastern Washington University. And, with the exception of the University of Washington, over half of incoming first year students in the state had GPAs within these middle ranges.

SAT/ACT Comparison for Washington's Public Baccalaureate Institutions First-Time, First-Year Students Entering Fall 2009 - Fall 2016

The following is a comparison of SAT and ACT scores for first-time, first-year students entering Washington's six Public Baccalaureate Institutions between fall quarter 2009 and fall quarter 2016. Data are from the Princeton Review. Princeton publishes the middle 50% of test scores (25th to 75th percentiles) rather than average scores, therefore it is not possible to definitively rank the institutions. An approximate TESC ranking was calculated using the midpoint of the middle 50th percentile and is provided under each test category for comparison.

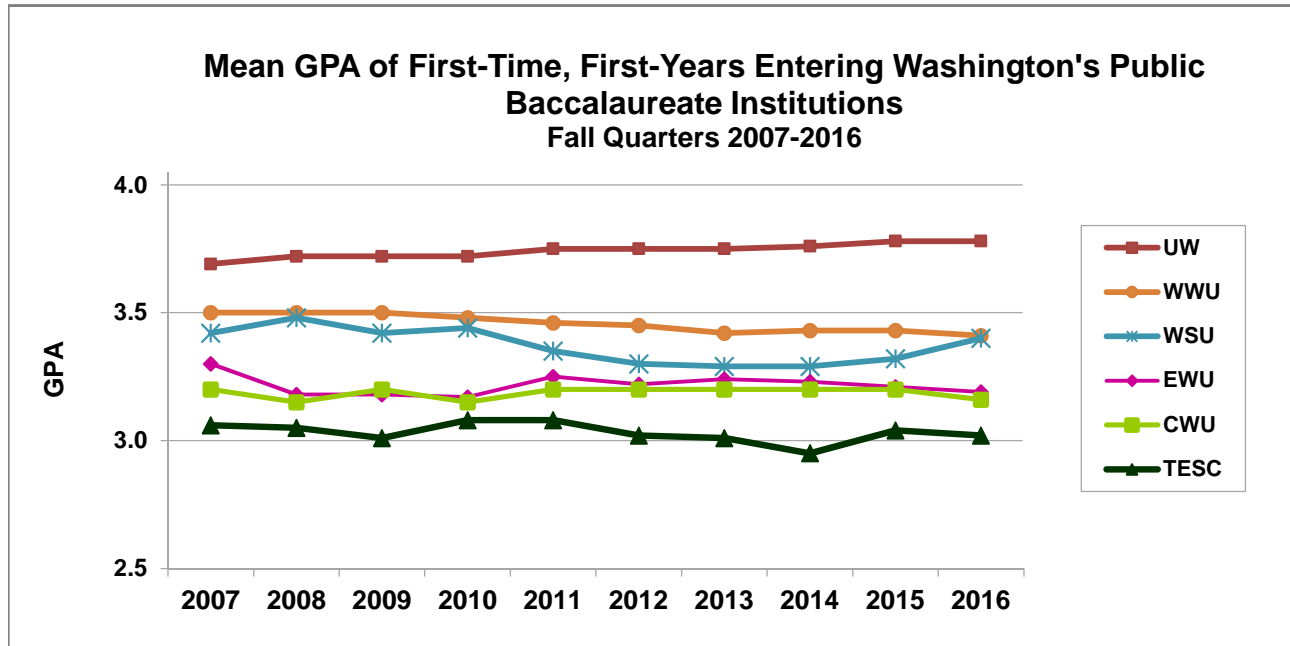
