

Academic Mentoring Day - Spring 2016

Wednesday May 11, 2016

Aggregate Summary Report

Spring quarter Academic Mentoring Day events took place in the Library building. The format was similar to Winter 2016, with a welcome table and readings of winning academic statements at 1:30. The first sessions began at 2:00 and the second set of sessions began at 3:00. Pauline Yu made brief welcome remarks at 1:30. The locations of the sessions were different than prior Mentoring Days; there were a few sessions offered in the library lobby, and four sessions offered in the corners of the library mezzanine. Free food made a come-back to Mentoring Day this quarter, with pizzas delivered to each session during the 2nd time slot. It was popular.

Faculty presenters collected attendance counts for the sessions, which resulted in **estimated attendance for Mentoring Day of 306, which compares to attendance of 165 at the previous Spring Mentoring Day 2015**. This is the highest Mentoring Day attendance since Spring 2014, and the third highest of all time. The spring event occurs on the same day as Transfer Advising Day, in which incoming transfers for fall 2016 are encouraged to participate in Mentoring Day sessions.

33 students came for Individual Academic Statement Review Sessions, 15 of whom RSVP'd prior to Mentoring Day, via a new sign-up process established this quarter.
