

Academic Mentoring Day - Spring 2018

Wednesday May 16, 2018

Spring quarter Academic Mentoring Day events took place in the Library building and Purce Hall.

The format was similar to the AY 16-17 year, with a welcome table at 1:30, the first sessions began at 2:00, and the second set of sessions began at 3:00. Mentor Council Chair Pauline Yu, along with Chassity Holliman-Douglas and Jennifer Drake made welcome remarks at 1:40, pizza was available at 1:45. Faculty were on hand during both sessions to read Academic Statements in the library lobby.

Faculty presenters provided attendance counts for the sessions, which resulted in **estimated attendance for Mentoring Day sessions of 147**, which compares to attendance of 342 at the previous Spring Mentoring Day 2017.

Additional context notes: Transfer Advising Day was held in the morning of May 16th and had a lower turnout than previous years. Black Focus/Black Student Union (student groups) held a Cultural Competency Wellness Rally on Red Square from 1-4pm.
