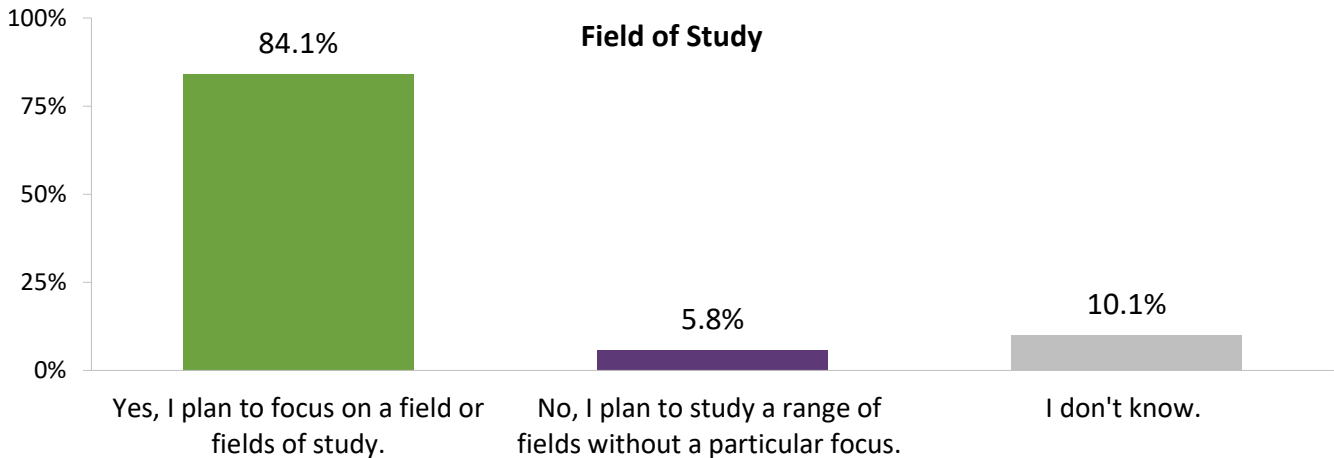


Do you plan to focus on a particular field or fields of study at Evergreen?

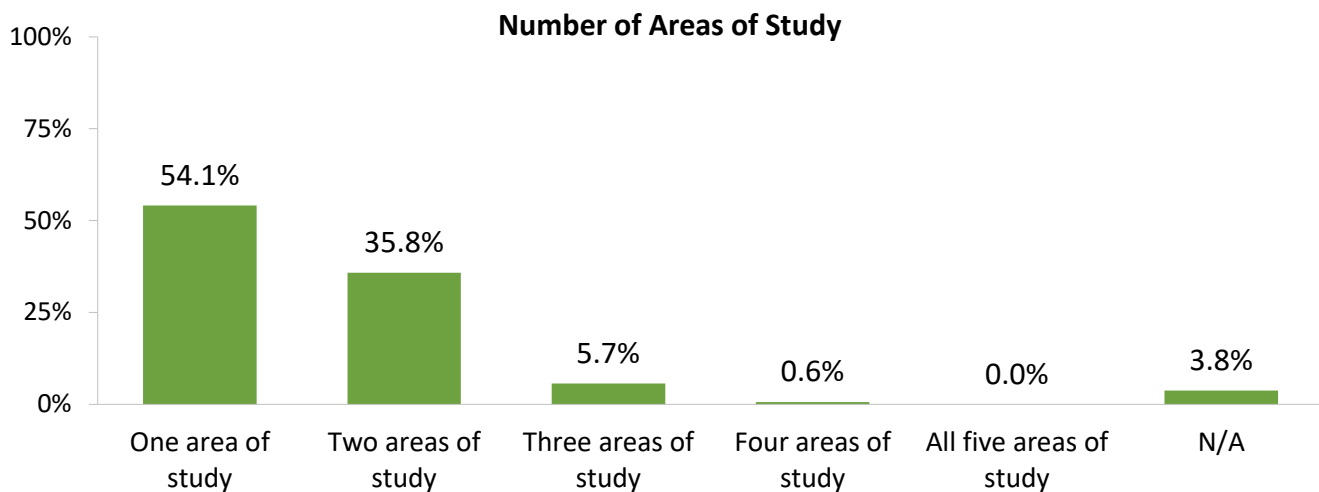
Transfer students were asked if they planned to focus on a particular field of study; 82% plan to focus on a field or fields of study, 7% plan to study a range of fields, and 10% do not know.

Number of Areas of Study

The students who plan to focus on a field or fields of study were asked to describe their focus. These open ended responses were categorized and are presented below. 54% of Transfer respondents indicated they will concentrate on one area of study, while 36% indicated two areas of study, 6% three areas of study, and 1% four areas of study. There were no students who plan to concentrate in all five areas of study. 4% of Transfer respondents did not give any further information about the area of study on which they intended to focus.



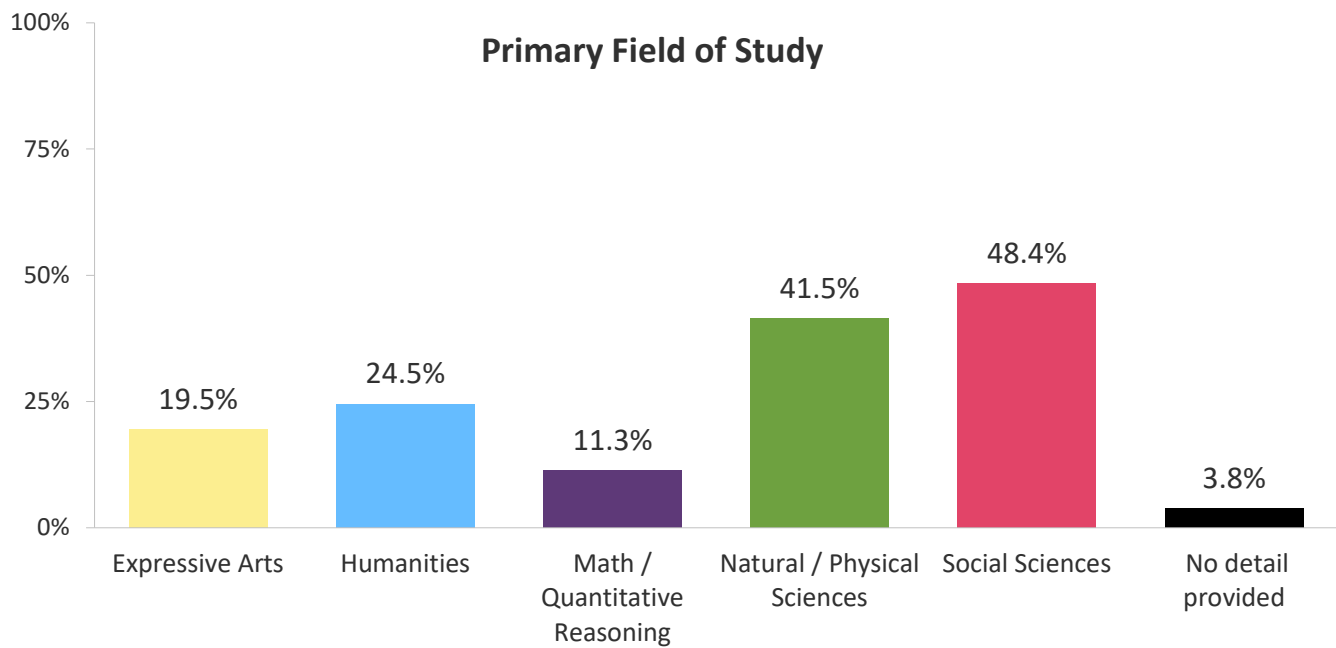
Describe your primary field(s) of study or concentration at Evergreen?

Students were asked to describe their primary field or fields of study at Evergreen. 20% plan to study Expressive Arts, 25% Humanities, 11% Math/ Quantitative Reasoning, 42% Natural/Physical Sciences, 48% Social Sciences, and 4% provided no detail. Students are allowed to choose more than one field, so the categories will not sum to 100%.
