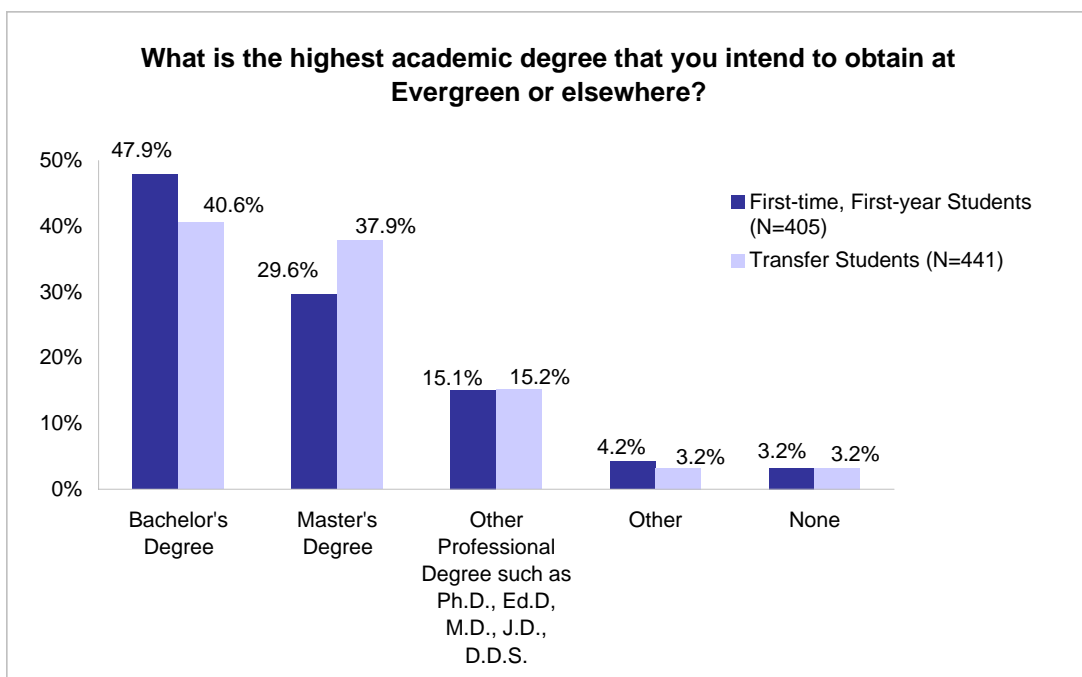

**What is the highest academic degree that you intend to obtain at Evergreen or elsewhere?**

Many new Evergreen students plan to earn a Bachelor's Degree (47.9% of first-time, first-years; 40.6% of transfer students) or Master's Degree (29.6% of first-time, first-years; 37.9% of transfer students). About fifteen percent of both groups plan to earn another professional degree such as Ph.D., Ed.D., J.D., M.D., or D.D.S. A few students aren't sure what degree they'll obtain (16 First-time, First-years; 6 Transfers), and a few plan to earn degrees not contained in the above categories, which are listed below.
