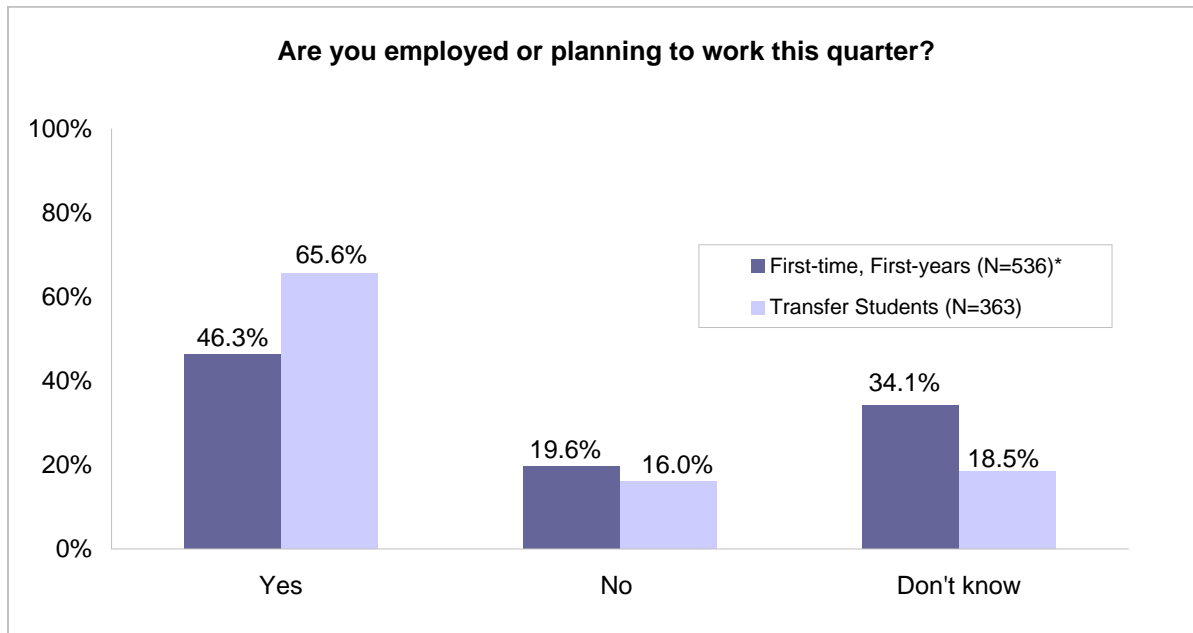

Are you employed or planning to work this quarter?

Of the survey respondents, 46.3% of the first-time, first-year students indicated that they were employed or planning to work this quarter compared to 65.6% of transfer students. A total of 19.6% of the first-time, first-year students and 16.0% of transfer students responded that they were not employed or planning to work. More first-time, first-year students (34.1%) responded "don't know" than transfer students (18.5%).

If yes, how many hours per week?

The following tables show students' responses to a question about the number of hours they planned to work if they were employed or planning to work fall quarter. A total of 75.7% of first-time, first-years who indicated that they were planning to work or were employed wrote in hours that were equivalent to part-time, 10.0% wrote in the equivalent of full-time, and 14.3% were unsure. Of transfer students who were employed or planning to work, 79.1% wrote in part-time hours, 16.1% indicated full-time work, and 4.8% were unsure.
