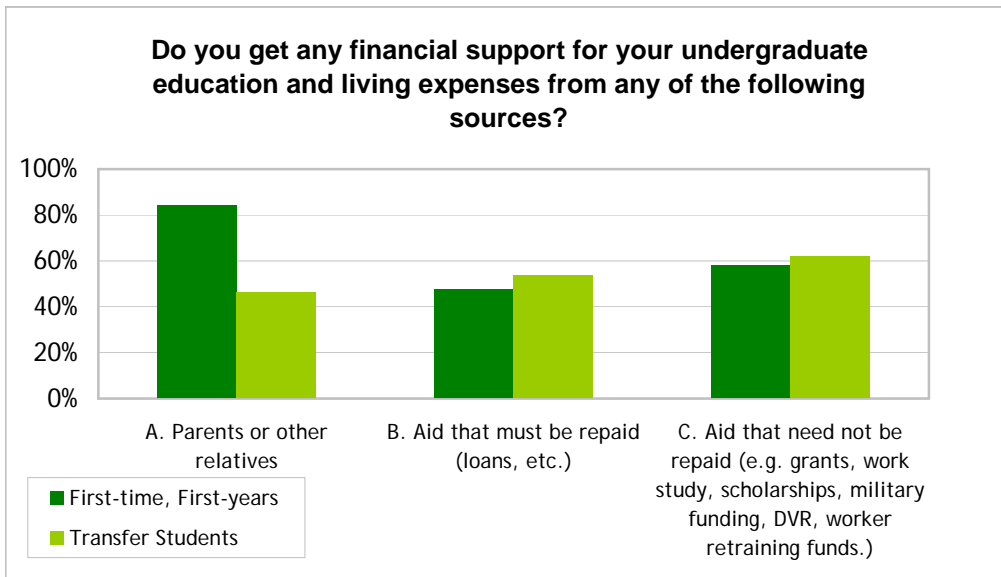

Financial Support

New students were asked about the financial support that they receive. A higher proportion of first-time, first-years reported financial support from parents or other relatives as compared to transfers students (84.3% of first-time, first-years compared to 46.6% of transfer students.) Almost half of first-time, first-years (47.6%) and a little more than half of transfer students (54.0%) reported receiving financial aid that must be repaid. More than half of both first-time, first-years (58.1%) and transfer students (62.2%) reported receiving aid that need not be repaid.
