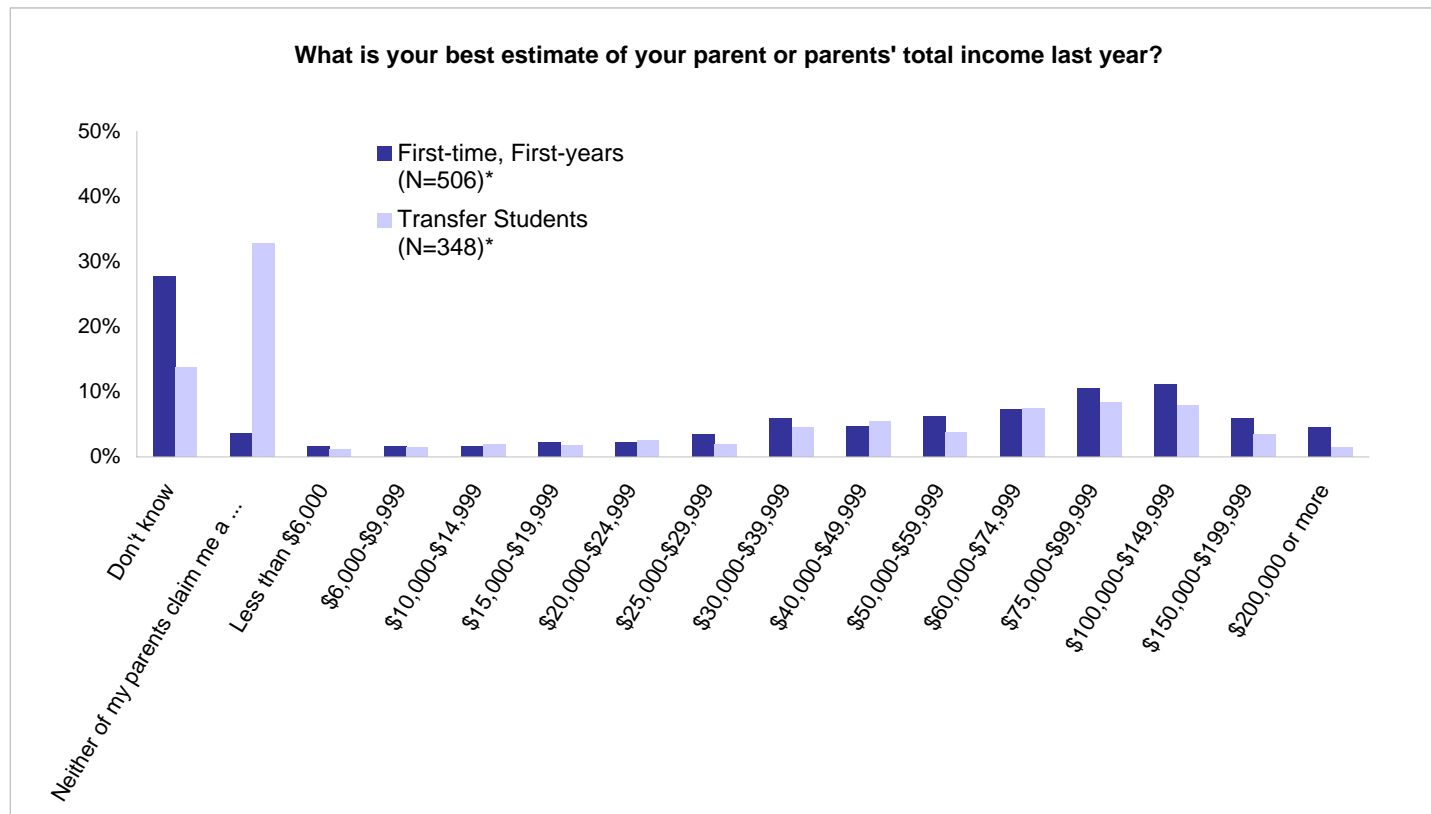

Parents' Income

New students were asked to give a best estimate of their parent or parents' total income last year. This question was asked of all new students, even though 53.4% of transfer students and 15.7% of first-time, first years reported no financial support from parents or other relatives. Responses to this question are the best estimate of parents' income and may not accurately reflect parents' actual income. A total of 33 first-time, first-years and 15 transfer students skipped this question. A total of 27.7% of first-time, first-years and 13.8% of transfer students didn't know their parents' income and 3.6% of first-time, first years and 32.8% of transfer students indicated that their parents' do not claim them as a dependant.
