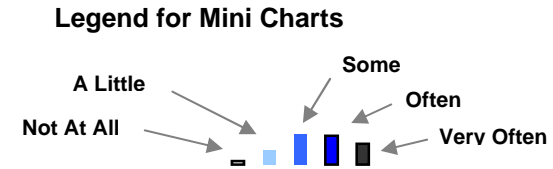

**How often have you...?**

New students were asked to indicate how often they had interacted with a series of groups and used some resources. For transfer students (like first-time, first-years), the item with the highest mean response was "Used the internet or other online sources to do research" while the item with the lowest mean response was "Gone to the library to do research." While 90.8% of transfer students indicated that they used the internet or other online sources to do research "Often" or "Very Often," only 64.4% reported going to the library to do research "Often" or "Very Often."
