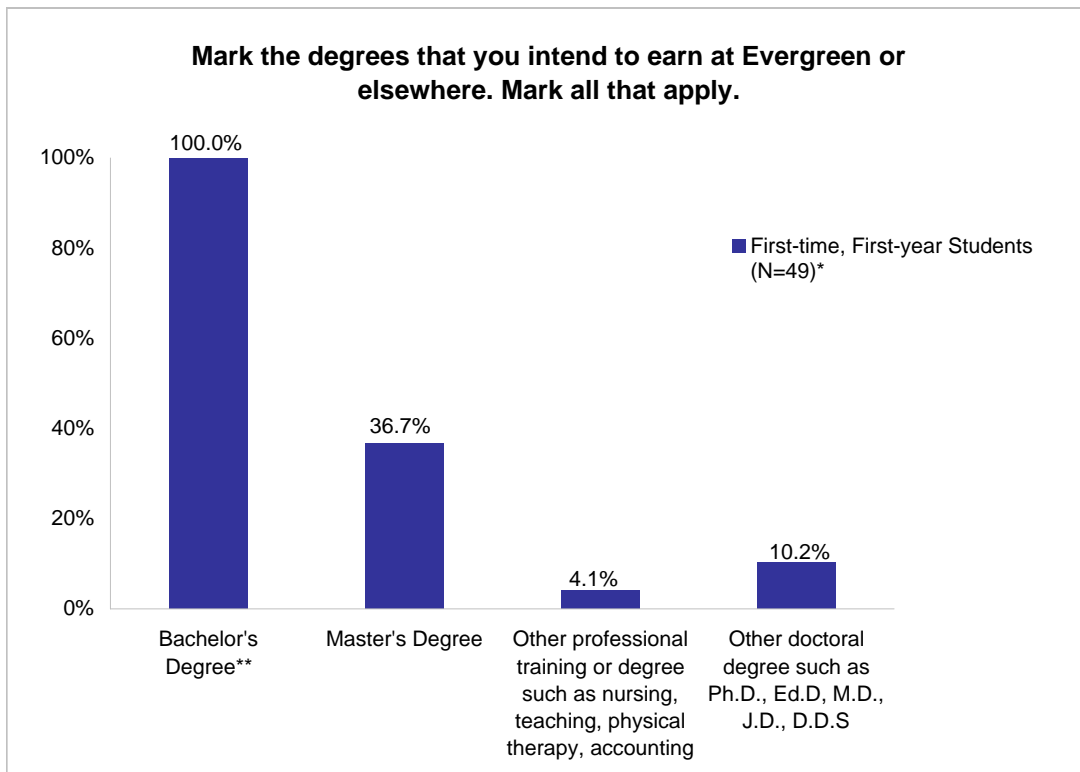

Tacoma Program

Mark the degrees that you intend to earn at Evergreen or elsewhere. Mark all that apply.

All surveyed Tacoma students planned to earn a Bachelor's Degree and 36.7% of those students plan to earn a Master's Degree. About ten percent of both groups plan to earn a doctoral-level degree such as Ph.D., Ed.D., J.D., M.D., or D.D.S.



Mark the degrees that you intend to earn at Evergreen or elsewhere.

* Percentages do not include the one student who skipped the question altogether.

** These numbers are adjusted; three students indicated that they planned to go on to earn a masters and/or doctoral-level education, but failed to mark a bachelor's degree. Two students also indicated that they planned to attend Evergreen until earning a Bachelor's degree on question 5 of the same survey. Therefore, students who indicated that they planned to earn a Master's degree or other doctoral level degree, were adjusted to also indicate intent to earn a bachelor's degree. The discrepancy is probably due to the "mark all that apply" question format. The unadjusted percentage of students that indicated that they planned to earn a Bachelor's degree is 93.9%.
