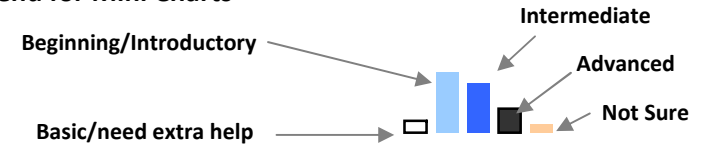

New students were asked to indicate the level of study they were most comfortable with as they began their studies at Evergreen. The table below shows levels of study for first-time, first-years sorted by the highest mean response to the lowest. The most common response is in bold for each item. The areas with the highest mean reported level of skill for first-time, first-years were: Reading for academic purposes, Using online sources to do research, and Writing for academic purposes. The areas with the lowest means were: Math, statistics, and/or quantitative reasoning; Performing arts; and Foreign language.
