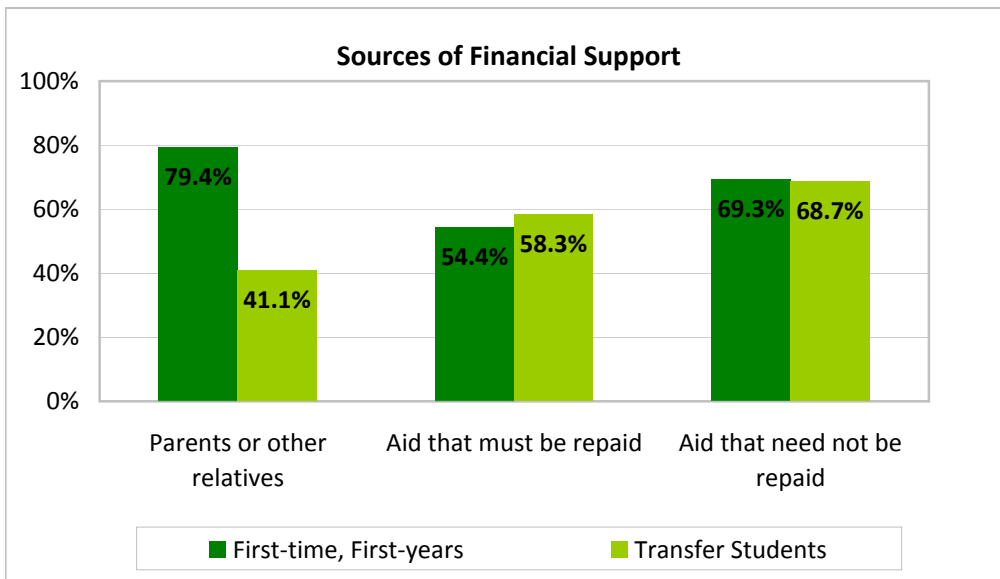

**Financial Support**

New students were asked about the financial support that they receive. A higher proportion of first-time, first-years reported financial support from parents or other relatives as compared to transfers students (79.4% of first-time, first-years compared to 41.1% of transfer students). More than half of first-time, first-years (54.4%) and transfer students (58.3%) reported receiving financial aid that must be repaid. More than two-thirds of both first-time, first-years (69.3%) and transfer students (68.7%) reported receiving aid that need not be repaid.
