

Do you plan to earn your Bachelor's Degree from Evergreen?

Most new students planned to stay at Evergreen until they earn their Bachelor's Degree (84.2% of first-time, first-year students; 95.7% of transfer students). First-time, first-year students more frequently indicated they were unsure whether they would earn a Bachelor's Degree from Evergreen (14.9%) than transfers (3.7%).
