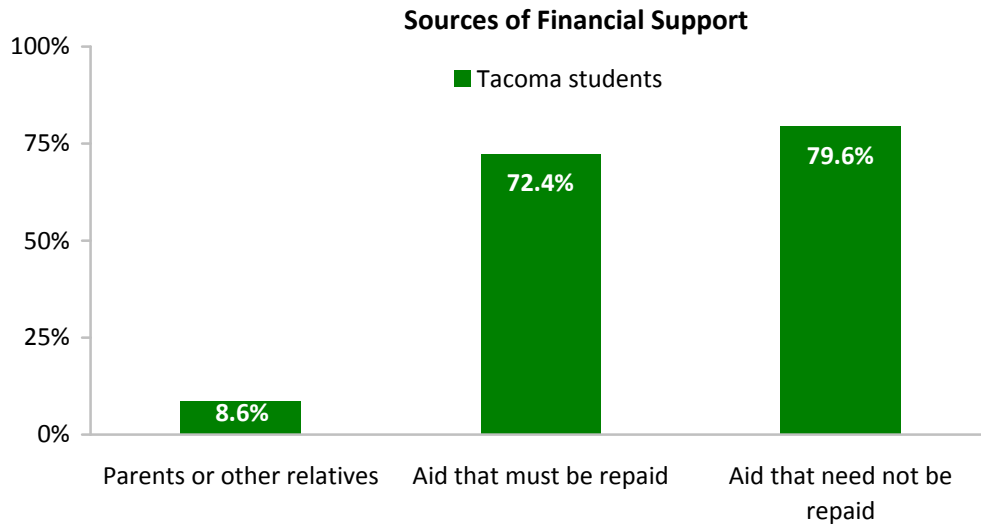

**Financial Support**

Tacoma students were asked about the financial support that they receive. Less than 9% reported financial support from parents or other relatives. More than 72% of Tacoma students reported receiving financial aid that must be repaid, whereas nearly 80% reported receiving aid that need not be repaid.
