

Students were asked in an open-ended question what they planned to do after graduation. Responses from Tacoma students were categorized and are summarized below. The most common responses were service to community (29.7%), job/intership (28.1%), followed by further studies (25%).



Of the Tacoma Campus respondents who indicated they wanted to get a job or internship, 10.9% indicated they wanted to become self-employed or start working for a business; 14.1% indicated they wanted to work for federal or state government, and 3.1% mentioned working for a non-profit organization.
