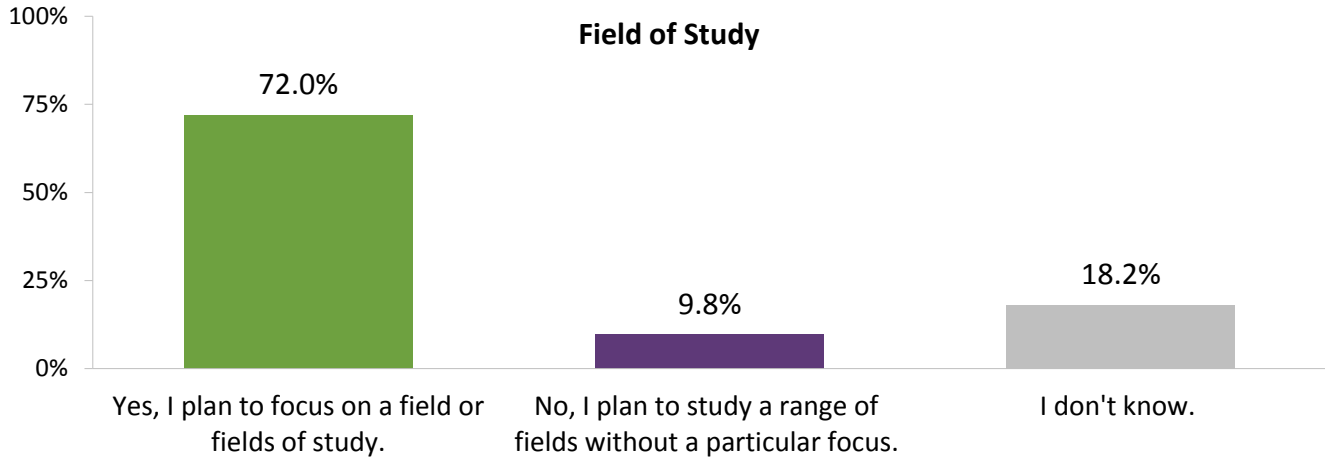


**Do you plan to focus on a particular field or fields of study at Evergreen?**

First-time, First-year students were asked if they planned to focus on a particular field of study; 72.0% plan to focus on a field or fields of study, 9.8% plan to study a range of fields, and 18.2% do not know.

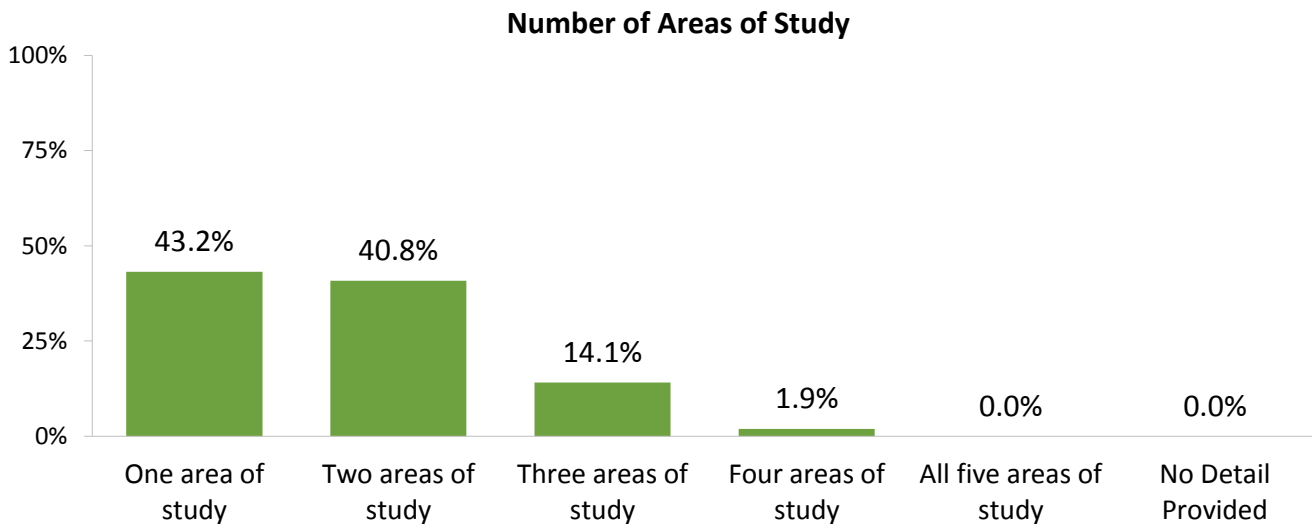

43.2% of First-time, First-year respondents indicated they are concentrating on one area of study, while 40.8% indicated two areas of study, and 14.1% three areas of study, no students were concentrating on all five areas of study, and none provided no detail.



***If yes, describe your primary field(s) of study or concentration at Evergreen?***

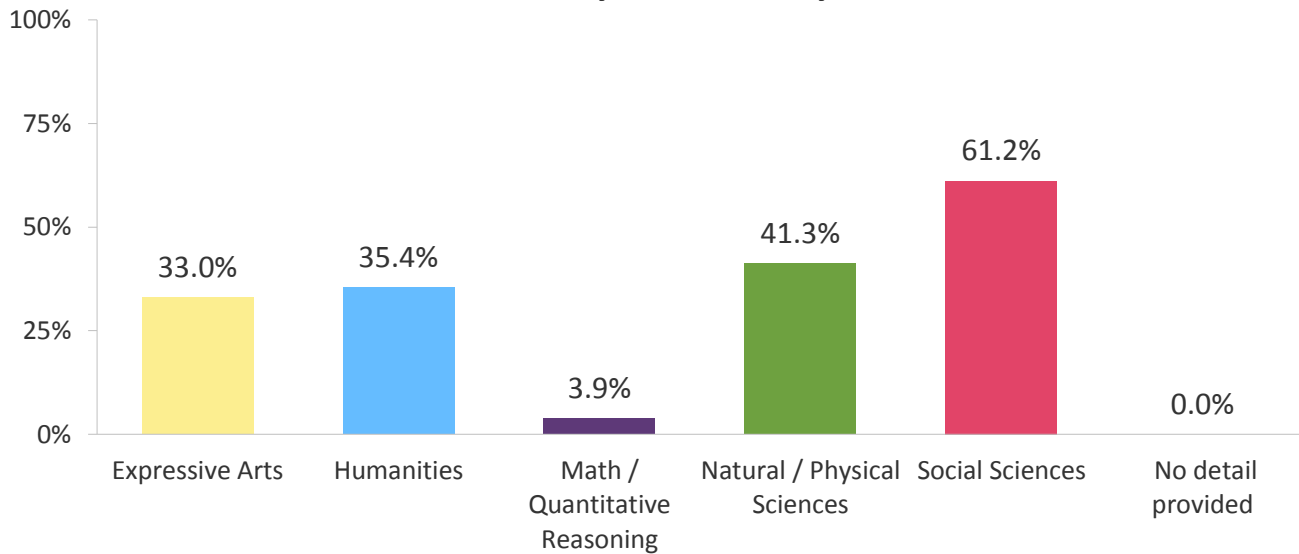
First-time, First-year students were asked to describe their primary field or fields of study at Evergreen. 33.0% study Expressive Arts, 35.4% Humanities, 3.9% Math/Quantitative Reasoning, 41.3% Natural/Physical Sciences, and 61.2% Social Sciences. There were no FTFY students who provided no detail. Students were allowed to choose more than one field, so the categories will not sum to 100%.
