


**Do you plan to earn your Bachelor's Degree from Evergreen?**

82.7% of First-time, First-year respondents and 97.6% of Transfers plan to earn their Bachelor's Degree from Evergreen. 1.1% of First-time, First-years do not plan to earn their degree at Evergreen. 16.2% of First-time, First-year and 2.4% of Transfers are unsure if they plan to earn their Bachelor's degree from Evergreen.
