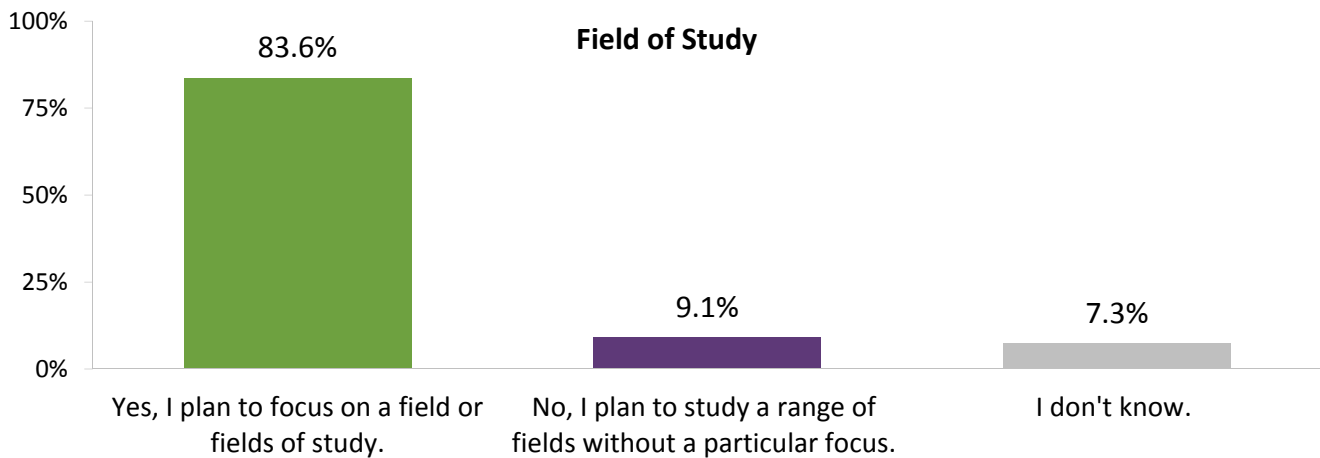


Do you plan to focus on a particular field or fields of study at Evergreen?

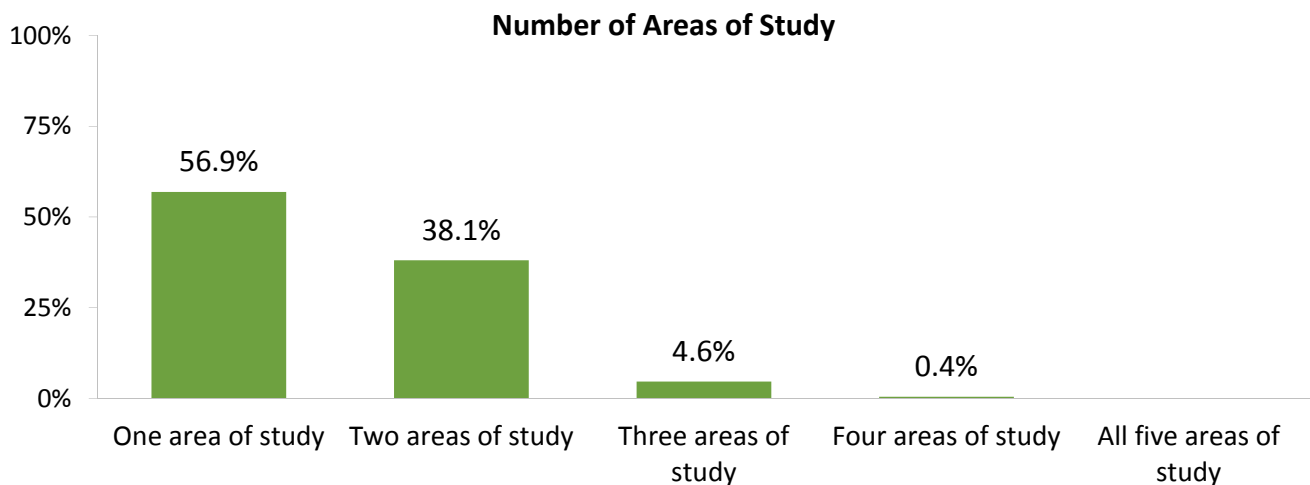

56.9% of Transfer respondents indicated they will concentrate on one area of study, while 38.1% indicated two areas of study, 4.6% three areas of study, and 0.4% four areas of study. There were no students who plan to concentrate in all five areas of study.

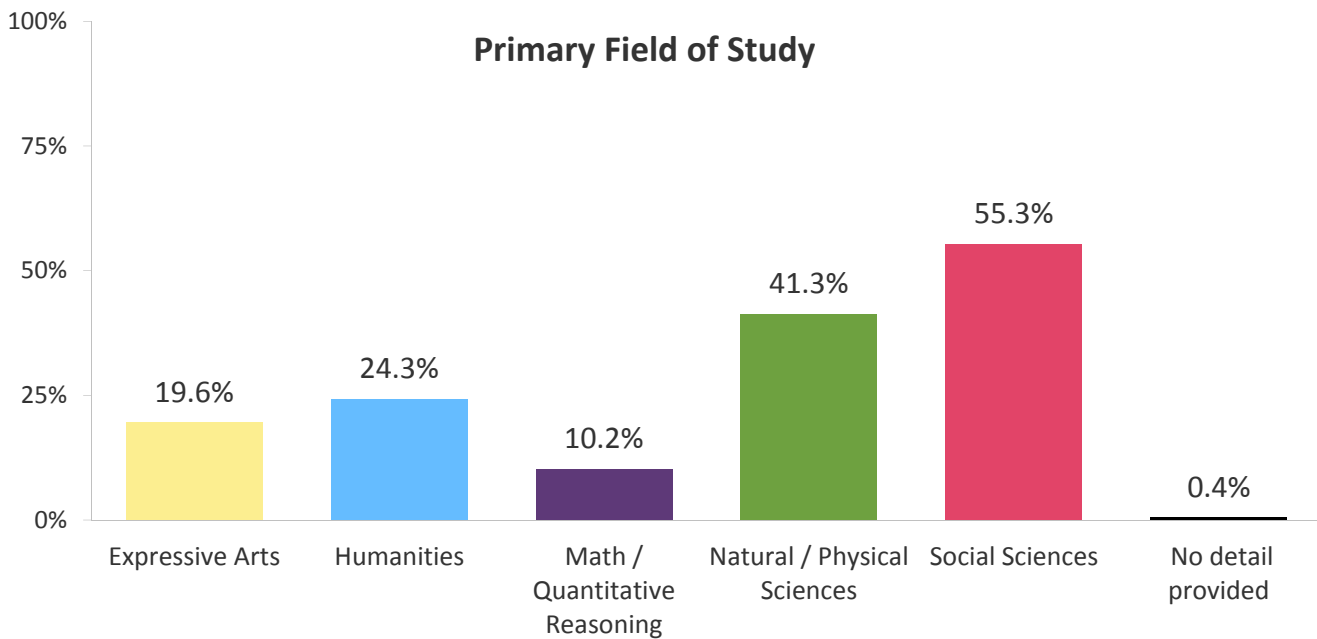


Describe your primary field(s) of study or concentration at Evergreen?

Students were asked to describe their primary field or fields of study at Evergreen. 19.6% will studying Expressive Arts, 24.3% Humanities, 10.2% Math/ Quantitative Reasoning, 41.3% Natural / Physical Sciences, 55.3% Social Sciences, and 0.4% provided no detail. Students are allowed to choose more than one field, so the categories will not sum to 100%.

My main focus as far as I know at this point will be on Foreign Language Studies (for a future as a teacher or interpreter, etc. abroad.) and Art.





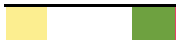
