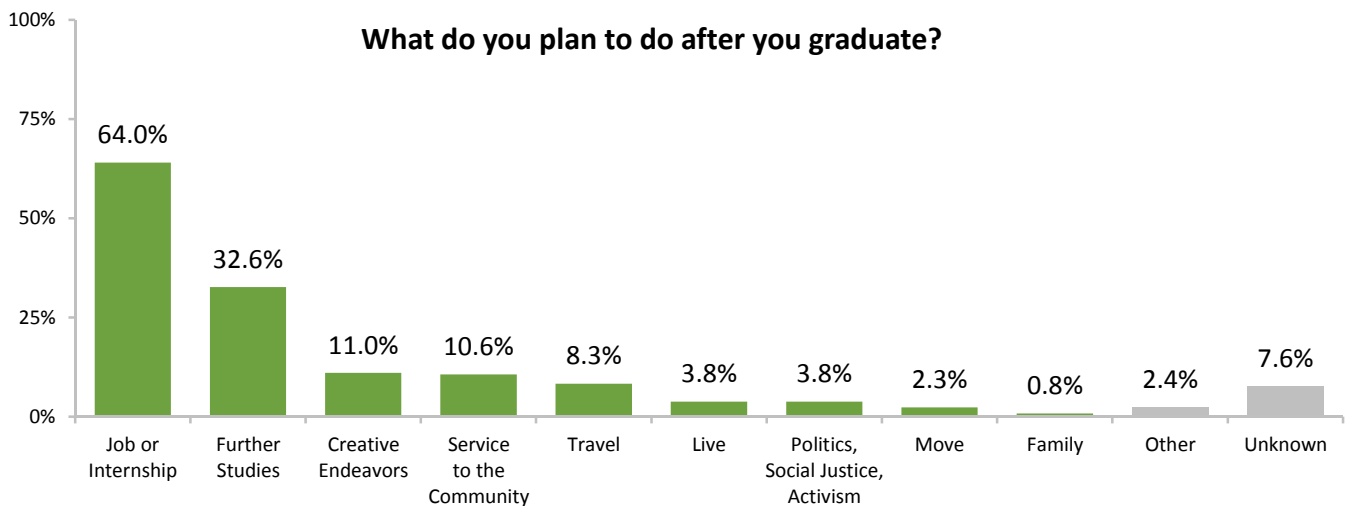


What do you plan to do after you graduate?*

Students were asked in an open-ended question what they planned to do after graduation. Responses from Transfer students were categorized and are summarized below. 64.0% of Transfer respondents plan to get a job after graduation, 32.6% plan to continue with their studies, 11.0% Creative endeavors, 10.6% want to serve their community, 8.3% want to travel, 3.8% live, 3.8% want to be involved with Politics, Social Justice, or Activism, 2.3% will move, and 0.8% take care of family. 2.4% are interested in something other than these categories and 7.6% of students do not know what they plan to do after they graduate. The categories are not mutually exclusive, so answers will not add up to 100%.
